Guest Player Eligibility

Guest Players. Where permitted by the rules of the tournament or special competition, players registered to one club may play as guest players for a team sponsored by another club. However, all managers and/or coaches of teams containing guest players must ensure that their guest players have obtained written permission from the club or clubs to which the players are registered and must produce the permission prior to the start of the competition. Failure to do so will disqualify those guest players from the competition. The written permission for guest players must be submitted to the District Vice President or the District Registrar of the team requesting the use of guest players, as well as the Director of the tournament. Such notification is to be made prior to the commencement of the tournament period.

Procedure for guest players – CJSA player/on a CJSA Club

1. Written permission from player's club president stating event and date player has permission to participate with other team.
2. Roster
 - a. Must show player as guest player
 - b. Roster must be stamped with Tournament Stamp
 - c. Roster must be district certified
3. Process in your district as you would any Application for Travel

Procedure for guest players – CJSA player/on an Out of State Team

1. Written permission from player's club president stating player is registered and in good standing, event and date player has permission to participate with other team
2. Copy of Player Pass
3. Written request from Team player is going to be participating with stating who they are and what National State Association they belong to and the event they are requesting permission for
4. Copy of Tournament Host Form
5. Forward items 1-3 to the State Administrator for further processing. After ensuring that all is in order the State Administrator will obtain the necessary permission for the CJSA State President.
6. The State Office will then notify the necessary National State Association and the team coach/manager in writing.

Procedure for Out of State Guest Players on a CJSA Team

1. 1-4 above
2. After ensuring that all is in order the State Administrator will obtain the necessary permission.
3. The State Office will then notify the necessary National State Association and the team coach/manager in writing.
