



Emergency Action Plan

Coaches and officials use their discretion to temporarily suspend or cancel events if conditions become unsafe. Coaches will send out a message via email to their team if an event in progress must be suspended or cancelled due to weather.

When inclement weather is in the forecast (e.g. high winds, hail, heavy rain, lightening), parents are reminded to:

- Remain at or near the practice or game facility
- Check their email often
- Identify another adult who can take responsibility for their child if they are unable to remain at or near the practice/game venue

In general, if inclement weather forces athletes to take shelter during an event at West Morris - Mendham High School, coaches will lead teams to the covered spaces outside of the locker rooms near the lower parking lot. If inclement weather forces athletes to take shelter at Mosle Field, there are no existing structures to accommodate large groups. Therefore, it is essential for families to remain at or near the field when inclement weather is in the forecast.
