Parents Code of Conduct

- **Be positive with your child** – They have accomplished something that few will ever be able to attain, by simply being apart of a hockey team. Never put your child down; encourage them.
- **Do not force your children to participate in sports**, but support their desires to play their chosen sport. Children are involved in organized sports for their enjoyment. Make it fun.
- **Encourage your child to follow the team rules.** Getting them to practice/games on time, adhering to team dress code and rules of the appropriate behavior, both on and off the ice, will make for a successful team and season.
- **Insist on good grades.**
- **Do not embarrass your child by yelling at players, coaches or officials.** By showing a positive attitude toward the game and all of its participants, your child will benefit. No bullying.
- **Insist your child show respect** of the team rules, game officials and show good sportsmanship all the time. The League does not tolerate unsportsmanlike conduct both on and off the ice.
- **Encourage your children to believe** in themselves and their ability as a team player. Positive input nets positive results.
- **Let the coaches have their time** with the team after practices and games. That is when coaches can have the undivided attention of their team to discuss the practice and the game.
- **Never confront the coach/assistant coach/team manager with emotional issues** in front of players during or directly after a training session or game. Please wait 24 hours and adhere to the EYHA Grievance Procedure. This is important to the development of your child and the sport. Communicate with the coaches and support them.
- **Encourage your child to have fun and play for the love of the game.** Be a positive role model for your child and others associated with the team.
- **I will never yell, taunt, threaten or inflict physical violence upon any player, coach, official or spectator at any youth hockey activity.**
- **I will refrain from the use of abusive or vulgar language, racial, ethnic or gender-related slurs at any time at the rink or any youth hockey function.** I will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from youth hockey games.
- **If you enjoy the game, learn all you can about hockey - and volunteer.**
- Any parent who cannot abide by these rules or violates them will be subject to further disciplinary action as stated in the EYHA Bylaw Article XI: Conduct.
