

Skate Guard for Greater Canandaigua Civic Center 2019-20

Greater Canandaigua Civic Center is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization serving Ontario County and beyond. GCCC operates as an ice rink from September through March. It is located at 250 North Bloomfield Road, Canandaigua, NY 14424.

GCCC Goals: To provide a safe venue for open ice-skating sessions. To provide a wholesome and enjoyable atmosphere for our patrons during open ice-skating sessions. To increase our attendance at open ice-skating sessions through meeting the previous goals.

Job Description:

The skate guards' primary duties are to:

- provide on- and off-ice supervision during open ice-skating sessions
- enforce facility rules on and off the ice for patrons' enjoyment and safety
- educate patrons about facility rules and policies
- patrol facility
- check for admission wristbands
- assist patrons in the event of an injury
- assist patrons in the event of a facility emergency
- attend staff training meetings

Additional duties may include but are not limited to:

- cleaning/garbage removal

Requirements:

Must be at least 18 years old.

First Aid and CPR certification desired but not required.

Must have your own transportation.

Must be available on Friday and/or Saturday nights, Sept through March from 7:30 pm-10 p.m. as well as New Year's Eve (from 6 pm-9:30pm).

Wage:

The skate guard will be paid New York State minimum wage.
