Columbine 20, Douglas County 46

The Columbine Freshman team suffered their first loss of the season against Douglas County last Thursday. The first half was a back and forth contest with both teams moving the football up and down the field. The Rebels moved the ball offensively in the first half with several players contributing. Running back Jeremy Ortega caught a pass from QB Michael Tait and raced to the end zone. Michael Tait also had a couple nice runs.

Some interesting officiating at the end of the first half saw the guys in stripes add time back on the clock. Douglas County used the final two seconds of the half to score the go-ahead touchdown. This seemed to take some momentum the Rebels had going away and gave Douglas County the lead (26-20), which they kept for the remainder of the contest.

Douglas County received the ball for the second half. They marched down the field and scored. So, the situation at the end of the first half ended up being a 14-point swing that the Rebels couldn't recover from. Additionally, the Rebels were ineffective on offense and couldn't get going. Douglas County held the Rebels to just a few first downs in the second half, shutting down the Columbine offense. The Rebels were forced to punt four or five times, as the Douglas County defense did a good job of adjusting to the Columbine offense. The Columbine defense was on the field a lot and tired. Douglas County took advantage of this to score several times.
