Wireless Policy

July 18, 2011

The Glenbrooke Swim and Tennis Club (Glenbrooke) Board of Directors has provided wireless network access for members in good standing. While this is a benefit for our membership, it is important that this service be utilized in a responsible manner.

The Glenbrooke Board of Directors is responsible for this policy and may update it at any time to reflect changes in technologies, capabilities, or other factors. Policy changes will be shared with all members.

Scope

This policy applies to all members of Glenbrooke and governs all wireless network connections provided by Glenbrooke.

Policy

1. Wireless network service usage is provided for authorized members of Glenbrooke. Members wishing to use the service must agree to abide by the Glenbrooke Wireless Policy prior to connecting to the network.
2. Use of the Glenbrooke wireless network will be free of charge to the Glenbrooke membership
3. Wireless network access will be restricted by use of a shared password among the membership of Glenbrooke. This password is provided to adult members in good standing who agree to Glenbrooke Wireless Policy
4. The Glenbrooke wireless shared password must not be provided to any adult member, child, or guest of Glenbrooke by any member. Passwords will be distributed at the discretion of the Glenbrooke Board of Directors.
5. The Glenbrooke Board of Directors reserves the right to periodically change the wireless network password, revoke access to certain members, or remove the wireless service entirely.
6. Members must use the wireless network responsibly. Unauthorized use of the Glenbrooke wireless network includes, but is not limited to:
 - Publicly visiting web sites which may be reasonably considered inappropriate in a family environment (e.g., websites portraying pornographic or violent material, or those with language unacceptable for the youngest members of the club).
 - Using the Glenbrooke wireless network to download or upload protected or copyrighted material
 - Engaging in any type of criminal behavior (<http://www.justice.gov/criminal/cybercrime/cclaws.html>)
7. Members may not perform technical modifications to computer equipment meant to evade security restrictions or other controls in place on the wireless network.
8. Users of the wireless network may not impersonate other members, attempt to access the devices of other members via the Glenbrooke network, perform network "sniffing", try to guess or "crack" computer account passwords, utilizing excessive network bandwidth, or negatively impact the experience of other members utilizing the Glenbrooke wireless network service.
9. It is the responsibility of members to ensure that computer devices capable of connecting to the Glenbrooke wireless network are not left unattended such that children and other unauthorized users inadvertently have network access.
10. Glenbrooke does not take responsibility for equipment unable to utilize the wireless network due to legacy components.
11. Glenbrooke does not take responsibility for equipment malfunction while utilizing the wireless network
12. Glenbrooke board of directors will always comply with requests from law enforcement agencies regarding the use of the Glenbrooke wireless network
13. Users of the Glenbrooke wireless network may not "extend" the network in any way, such as providing network sharing or creating "ad hoc" wireless networks
14. Glenbrooke cannot guarantee the confidentiality of any data transmitted using the Glenbrooke wireless network service. Data requiring a higher level of security is the responsibility of the member performing the data transmission.
15. It is the responsibility of users of the wireless network to ensure that computers are adequately protected using antivirus and up-to-date software patches. Glenbrooke does not provide network firewalls, antivirus, or other security services.
16. The Glenbrooke Board of Directors has the authority to disconnect any device from the wireless network that violates the practices set forth in this policy. It is the responsibility of the user to be knowledgeable of the information set forth in these policies.

Violations

Violations of this policy may result in the suspension of Glenbrooke wireless network privileges, termination of membership, or prosecution for unlawful activity, and will be decided by the Glenbrooke board of directors on a case-by-case basis.
