Each parent is required to read the following Policy Statement, sign where indicated, return the form to his or her child's team Manager and, throughout the year, fully comply with the Code of Conduct. Parents, spectators and players who do not comply with the Code of Conduct will be penalized in the form of suspensions and, in the case of repeated or particular offenses, expulsion for the remainder of the year.
