

USSF Risk Management Policies advise that ONLY the following information regarding referees can be contained in the directory provided to certified assignors:

1. Full Name
2. E-mail address
3. Referee Grade
4. Year of Birth or Age
5. Date Attained Present Grade
6. City
7. Area/District

Thus, CSRP will only provide certified assignors with the above information. It will be provided either via ctreferee.net to all currently certified Connecticut assignors using a secure log in and/or via Central Assign for the currently certified assignors that are using the web based system provided by CSRP. Under no circumstances will CSRP provide any other information.

Referees, as independent contractors, need to provide information directly to the entity that hires them(Association, League, Club) for the purpose of being compensated.

If the assignor has entered into a contractual relationship with the referee and is paying that referee the game fees, he/she may obtain necessary information for the purpose of compensation from the contracted referee.

If referees want to be contacted by an assignor any other way than by e-mail, it is the responsibility of the referee to provide the assignor with a phone number. The assignor can also request a phone number from the referee in order to provide last minute information such as cancelations, changes of time, changes of venue, etc.
