Meeting Minutes: February 19, 2013

Call to Order

South Central District Vice President Joseph Conte called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Secretary's Report

Michael Galbicsek-SCD Secretary was absent due to illness. Keli Sorrentino distributed the minutes from the January 2013 South Central District meeting. The minutes were also emailed to the club Presidents and Representatives who signed up through the SCD website. During a brief discussion regarding the minutes, Mrs. Duffy pointed out an error regarding a full page advertisement for the Hall of Fame dinner – it was approved up to \$1000 rather than the \$100 reported in the minutes.

Michael Hanlon-SCD Treasurer stated the current financials were emailed out to all clubs registered with the SCD. He also requested all spring transmittal forms be completed through SCD website as soon as team registrations are completed.

Registrar's Report

As discussed in previous months, Patrick Duffy-SCD Registrar asked everyone to submit their birth certificates online. Once Duffy reviews the birth certificate the player will be eligible to participate in league play without issues. Moreover, Duffy recommended all club president review the background check system provided by the CJSA to ensure all of their coaches are registered. In anticipation of teams registering for summer league, a reminder was made to use the "rec" division rather than the "high school" division for these teams. There were no further questions for Duffy.

District Referee Administrator's Report

There was no referee report since Raul Marques-SCD DRA was absent.

Girl's Commissioner's Report

Scott Bradley-SCD Girls Commissioner stated that most towns have their teams registered. Bradley reported that he and the boy's commissioner will be working on the divisions soon and will do their best to place teams in their requested division. Division size should be 5-6 teams. There was a suggestion from a town representative to increase the rec divisions to 8-10 teams so they are insured more games because they do not participate in cup or tournament play.

Boy's Commissioner's Report

Bill Cadwell-SCD Boys Commissioner was absent. Scott Bradley-SCD Girls Commissioner reiterated the points made for the girl's divisions.

U-10 Commissioner's Report

Brian Grindrod-SCD U10 Commissioner and Recreation Director was absent from the meeting however SCD Vice President Joseph Conte reported on Grindrod's behalf. There were no issues pertaining to the U-10 divisions and asked if any clubs had information for Grindrod to email him.

State/CJSA Report

Joseph Conte-SCD Vice President reported for Brian Grindrod. Each club can now check on background check statuses on the registrar website. March 10 is premier scheduling. There have been changes made to E and D licenses. Southwest District will no longer charge out-of-district teams to play in their leagues. Discussion of social media policy was tabled until March. Discussion of providing lanyards for passes to be able to identify coaches and other volunteers with completed background check. Each district was asked to discuss and determine their interest in requiring lanyards. After a discussion, a vote was taken with a unanimous NO vote.

Vice President's Report

Joseph Conte-SCD Vice President reported that next month we will meet upstairs. Tentative order for scheduling on Sunday, March 3: Start with U10 divisions then the order would be U12girls, U14girls, U12boys, U14boys and finally U16 & U19 boys and girls. Encouraged to have present only one coach or manager per team and one field coordinator per town. Once your team is scheduled, please leave the scheduling room. The division champion shirts are available for pick-up after the meeting. There were 652 shirts ordered! There was a brief discussion of enforcing a strict deadline in the future to avoid any delay in players receiving their shirts.

New Business

Joseph Conte-SCD Vice President presented the following item to the group to vote on.
