PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

As parents/guardians, you play a special role in contributing to the needs and development of children playing baseball. Through your encouragement and good example, you can help assure that they will learn good sportsmanship.

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to maintain the highest standard of sportsmanship and ethical behavior at all times.

As a Parent/Guardian I agree:

I will focus on my child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.

I will remember that all children participate to have fun and that the game is for youths, not adults.

I will support my child's commitment to his team by assuring regular attendance at practices and games.

I will remain at my child's practice or game; coaches are not responsible for children who are left at a game or practice.

As a spectator I am expected to abstain from and need to understand that the following will not be tolerated:

Booing or ridiculing officials, players, and/or game coaches.

Using obscenities, profanity, unsportsmanlike remarks, or gestures.

Arguing with coaches, umpires, parents or spectators for any reason.

Being intoxicated or impaired by alcohol or any other substance.

Entering or attempting to enter the field of play or the dugouts during pre game, game or post game activity.

Physical violence or threat of physical violence.

Alcohol or tobacco is prohibited at any practice, game, event, activity and, according to Board of Education policy, prohibited on School Property, including parking areas.

I will abide by the rules of New Fairfield Baseball, and all league policies, as well as all decisions made by the Governing Board.

I also agree: If I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:

- 1) Verbal warning by the coaching staff, and/or the NF Baseball President/Board.
- 2) Written warning.
- 3) Game suspension with written documentation kept on file.
- 4) Season suspension.
- 5) Removal of child from the league.
