

EBA GRANT IN AID POLICY

Rookie/PeeWee/Developmental/House:

Any EBA player is allowed to apply for a scholarship up to the total fee amount in their Rookie/PeeWee/Developmental/House program each season.

Travel:

Each player is allowed one full travel scholarship per their potential four years (grades 5-8) in travel basketball.

Each player can receive the House Player fee amount each of their potential four years in travel basketball to be applied to their total fees due each year in travel basketball.

Each traveling family is allowed only one travel player on full travel scholarship each year.

Players/parents can “earn” the funds for scholarships after their one travel scholarship allowed is used up by working at the EBA tournaments for an hourly fee if agreed upon by the EBA at the beginning of the season.

Any travel player receiving a scholarship of any kind is to receive a letter from the EBA outlining and confirming the above each year they receive any funds.

All players are responsible for the cost of their traveling uniform. There are no scholarship funds for any uniform costs.

Overall:

The policy should reflect that applicants need to specify the amount of their request so the EBA is not just automatically providing the maximum amount of the applicable fee to each applicant.
