



2017 TBC Shootout Rules

Game Day

- Teams will consist of no more than 10 players
- Games will be one **25 minute** session with running clock
- All games will start and end on a whistle

Rules and Regulations

- Teams will consist of no more than 10 players
- No more than 4 players (1-2-1) plus goalie at a time
- 3v3 Behind Restraining Line
- Age brackets will be as follows (grades based on 2016/2017 school year):
3/4, 5/6, 7/8
- Each team is allowed two parent-coaches
- Each game will be 25 minutes with a running clock
- No long sticks permitted
- All penalties will result in a three on two fast break
- 3 games guaranteed per team plus a possible championship game
- Games will begin at 10 AM and end at 5 PM (final schedule to be emailed to coaches by February 22nd)
- Faceoff to start every game.
- If a game is tied at end of regulation, there will be sudden death overtime, with a maximum 2 minute running clock. If no one scores, the game will end in a tie. Faceoff will decide possession to start overtime.
- Officials are responsible for keeping score.
- Full names, grades, as well as a parent phone number and email must be included with registration for every player on a team.
- Brackets may be changed or added based on player registration
- A signed waiver must be received from every player prior to the start of the tournament.
- **Teams must register by Tuesday, February 21**
