### Camp Highlights:

#### **1v1 Series:**

Each day we highlight a small number 1v1 moves to the campers. Campers are given instruction in performing the move and then are provided with different 1v1 games each day that assist the campers in developing their technical and tactical understanding of the moves.

#### **Training Sessions:**

Training sessions will be geared to help players improve techniques of dribbling, passing, shooting, and receiving. Sessions will also help players improve their tactical decision making within game settings. Instruction will focus on attacking and defending in 1v1 through 2v2 situations for the less experienced players and up through 4v4 for the more experienced players.

#### **Little Soccer Hornets (ages 5-6):**

Campers will learn soccer skills through fun games and soccer activities. This is a half day camp only.

#### **High School Prep Training:**

Pre High School aged (entering 8<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade) campers with advanced skills will be challenged through more advanced technical and tactical soccer activities and games. The training will help prepare them for what they will experience at the high school level.
