3. Approval of the April minutes
 - a. April minutes approved
4. President's Report
 - a. Opening day feedback
 - i. We received positive feedback on the event from parents and sponsors. The activities for the kids was well received and generated additional sponsorship donations.
 - b. Memorial Day All-Star Games
 - i. Metals are ready for game day ceremonies
 - ii. Volunteers needed for announcing and music
5. Finnegan Tournaments – Begins July 11th
 - a. Tourney director role
 - i. Brad Rasco and Michael Goday will co-chair the Finnegan Tournament
 - ii. Brad will handle the planning leading into the tournament
 - iii. Michael will handle the tournament

 - i. Tournament directors to organize planning and implementation
 - c. Request for volunteers
 - i. Tournament directors to work with 8U commissioner, coaches, and parents to support volunteer effort required for tournament.
 - ii. Request 9U parents with district team participants to make a 2 day volunteer commitment.
6. 50/70 Tourney – Begins June 20th

 - i. Gray Lambe was tentatively identified as the tournament director

 - i. Tournament directors to organize planning and implementation
 - c. Request for volunteers
 - i. International tournament has specific roles related to score keeper and pitch counter which need to be identified for the tournament.

9. 2015 / 2016 election cycle
 - a. Staggering of elections for transition purposes and Big Board open spots
 - b. Several open spots on the “Big” GEYA board for consideration

11. District 28 evaluation process
 - a. All district evaluations use a standardize skill set measurement process
 - b. Three evaluations have taken place – final is Minor B May 29
 - i. Opportunities to improve the evaluations
 - ❖ Add ½ point into rating scale
 - ❖ Add ground ball fielding into outfield assessment
 - c. All team selections to be reviewed by board prior to final announcements
 - d. Minor A coach selection
 - i. The board listened to feedback from a number of attendees regarding the Minor A coach selection
 - ii. No decision was made related to the Minor A coach
 - iii. Rookie 8s and league age 7 year old participation
 - ❖ No league age 7 players will be allowed to participate in Rookie 8 district tournament.
12. Commissioners’ Reports
 - a. 7U – Successful season wrapping up with improvement seen across all playing levels.
 - b. 8U – The board reiterated the need to follow the rules posted on the website. The change in age to the division has require additional focus on development.
 - c. Minor B – Regular season finishes on May 21st with playoffs to follow. Coaches have reported significant improvement in pitching and fielding.
 - d. Minor A – Regular season finishes on May 21st with playoffs to follow.
 - e. 50/70 – Regular season finishes on May 21st with playoffs to follow. One make-up game scheduled for completion prior to the start of the playoffs
