3. Approval of the August 14th meeting minutes:

 - a. Baseball currently has 2 at large spots (Dave Franz and Kris Kuzmick). The Big Board wants the 2 baseball terms to alternate, so we need 1 new volunteer to take Kris' spot. Dave Franz to continue for an additional 1 year term. Pat Kelly volunteered for the new spot and will attend the next Big Board Meeting.
