

Q: What is the registration fee for the cheerleading program?

Registration is \$150 per cheerleader with a \$300 max family registration with cheer and football. This is non-refundable after the 1st week of camp/practices

Q: What grades are allowed to participate in cheer?

Our youth cheerleading program starts with children entering 2nd grade all the way through 8th grade.

Q: What is the weekly practice schedule?

Practice for the month of August will be three nights a week. In the past practice nights have been Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.

Practice for the month of September will be two nights a week.

Practice for the month of October will go back to 3 nights a week to prepare for competition (days and time are TBD).

Q: Are there any cheerleading clinics set-up before practice starts?

Yes, these clinics are mandatory for new cheerleaders. Date and Time will be provided in June.

Q: Do I need to purchase the cheer uniform?

No, the cheerleading uniform is provided to each child. The uniform consists of the Shell, Skirt and long sleeve black undershirt.

Q: What should my child wear for practice?

- Shorts with no zipper, sequins, buttons, snaps, pockets, or loops.
- Fitted Shirt with no zipper, sequins, button, snaps, pockets, or loops.
- No Sports Bras unless it is worn under a shirt.
- No Jewelry of any kind!
- Hair needs to be up in a pony tail
- Bring a water bottle and please make sure your child's name is on the water bottle to ensure she leaves with the water bottle she came with.

Q: Are there any other items or fee's that my child will need for the season?

- Cheer Sneakers are required for all cheerleaders. We will provide the sneaker information prior to the first week of practice. (Depending on size the cost is around \$35.00 - \$50.00 this is subject to change every season)
- Cheer Bows are also part of our uniform. You will need to inform your child's coach the first week of practice if she will need one. (Cost \$20.00 per bow price is subject to change)
- Cheer Briefs will be needed to go under your cheer uniform. We will provide the website information during the first week of practice with ordering information.
- Black Leggings for those chiller Sunday morning games and black gloves.
- Cheer Jackets are not mandatory but are available for purchase.

Q: When are the football games played?

All of our football games are played on Sundays with one Saturday night game during the season. Each squad needs to arrive one hour prior to the game for warm ups and a quick practice.

Mites and Mighty Mites (Grades 2-4): 11:30 – 1***

Peewees (Grades 5&6): 2:30 – 4***

Midgets (Grades 7&8): 1 – 2:30***

Q: Are there any parent volunteer opportunities?

Yes, we ask that each parent volunteer 3+ hours every season. Volunteering consists of helping with different areas during home games (gate duty, snack shack, 50/50, announcer etc.)

Q: Do the cheerleaders do any type of fundraising during the season?

Yes, there are a few opportunities throughout the season for the cheerleaders to Fundraise. We ask that all cheerleaders participate in these fundraisers as it helps with the cost of new cheer equipment and competition fees.

Q: Typically how long is the cheerleading season?

Our Cheerleading season starts in August (not including clinics in July) and ends in November.

Q: Do the cheerleaders participate in any competitions?

Yes, the cheerleaders do 2-3 competitions. These competitions are normally in November but the dates and times will be determined closer to the start of the season.
