

Minutes of the Regular Meeting
of the
Baldwinsville Boys Lacrosse Booster Club
Tuesday, March 13, 2012

ATTENDEES: Ellen Paprocki, Shelly Klein, Joe Burchill, Michael Candee, Kim Candee, John Doyle, Hugh McCabe, Kevin Ferrigan, Adrienne Rutkowski, Gary Stewart, Christine Kirchner, Lorilee Bulak, Jacki Coe, Wendy Hamm, Ken Kaminski, Bob Kohutanich, Mary Delpha.

Ellen Paprocki called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Kim Candee motioned to approve the minutes with a minor change. Hugh McCabe seconded the motion. All approved. Jacki Coe will contact Sammy Malone's to get additional details regarding a possible fundraiser. Joe Burchill reported that Sammy's is interested in working with the booster club.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Ellen reported that 47 boys attended the Pine Grove Clinic. To date all but one paid. The coaches liked the setting but may separate the boys next year so the grouping is smaller. Pine Grove charged us \$250.00 per hour for full field.

The club was assessed a \$2,800.00 late fee for filing taxes late. We filed a letter asking for forgiveness. There are accountants looking into the matter. Our current taxes will be filed on time.

Varsity and JV pictures are scheduled for Thursday 3/22 after practice. We will look into 3/21 instead. The club has not heard back from Steve Miller yet. When the modified teams are set, their pictures will be scheduled.

JV Scrimmage 3/22 6:00-7:30 pm. Varsity scheduled to depart at 6:45 pm.

Helmet decals have been ordered and are on the way.

Ellen will notify 9th and 10th graders about ULA Lax so they are aware of this opportunity. Simmons may not be an option this year.

The booster club may look into interfacing with B'ville Youth Lax programs.

The Team Store on the website is open. There is a link to Scholastic Sports. Orders can be placed online through April 2nd. Long sleeve shirts for \$20.00, Polo Shirts for \$33.00, Shorts for \$21.00 and Jackets for \$48.00. The BBLBC will realize \$2.00-\$3.00 profit for each item sold. Delivery will take place within two weeks. There will be another opportunity to order possibly 4/13-4/20.

The booster club will provide varsity coaches with shirts and jackets to wear for all games. Cost for all three coaches is approximately \$250.00. Joe Burchill makes motion to approve and Shelly Klein seconds the motion. All approved.

Summer Camp will cost \$150.00. It will cost \$250.00 for two boys in same family. The district requires \$5.00 per kid for insurance. Proceeds from camp will be divided as follows: booster club to take \$5.00 per kid, all expenses for pinny, balls etc. will be paid for out of this money and remaining money will be divided as coaches fees.

Star Spangled Tournament-Discussion was held with Mike Collins (President of Girls Lacrosse Booster Club) regarding a way for BBLBC to raise money. We need to submit an idea. The possibility of a Radar Gun Booth was discussed with the highest speed winning. We need to look into insurance and the logistics (carport and tennis courts) of this. Mary Delpha will talk to Bob Clarkson regarding this and report back to the club.

There was also discussion about selling fruit.

Kiwanis club donated \$500.00 to the Baldwinsville Boys Lacrosse Booster Club. The club thanks them for their generosity!

There will likely be a game change for JV and Varsity on 5/5/12. SATs are held that day.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Net profit from Lansing and Pine Grove was \$570.00. We still have a \$20.00 receivable.

Kiwanis was the only other new revenue.

7/8 team-money owed is \$210.00 for a clinic at Jones Road.

The booster club currently has \$2,044.25 in our account.

100% of participants at all booster club clinics or tournaments are expected to pay for their participation. The only exception is if there is a financial hardship that has been approved by the booster club. The club's bylaws make this clear. We may need to articulate criteria for hardship cases. However, they will be handled on a case by case basis at this time.

WEBSITE UPDATE: Official game schedule is located on Digital Sports. You can access link or the Team Page on the website for game schedules. You can print pdf schedules for your team via the Team Page. We need a way to post results for all teams. Hugh McCabe will post Varsity results. Discussion was held about investigating a team manager for posting results. They would have limited access to website for this purpose.

*Rosters with numbers will be given to Hugh. He will post on website so they can be printed.

Kevin Ferrigan suggested looking into connecting with Lacrosse Unlimited or various other businesses to advertise on website. We may investigate this further.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Program-Joe Burchill reported that Mike Barker will do the printing this year. We would like to print 150-200 programs. A tax deduction form will be provided. The club also discussed the possibility of providing a restaurant gift card. Last year the booster club made a \$400.00 profit.

Fundraising- Kim Candee reported that the raffle tickets are ready. They will be handed out once the rosters are set. Raffle tickets will be handed out at the Varsity scrimmage.

Team representatives will be set by Friday.

Tournaments-The boys will play in the SU tournament. Kevin is still gathering information regarding the John Pepper tournament. Ellen said go ahead and commit to the SU tournament.

Concessions- We didn't have the response that we needed to volunteer in the concession stand. We need two volunteers for each game maybe three for busier games. Adrienne Rutkowski will send emails to solicit volunteers. A meeting is needed with Brian Wright (Head of Food Service).

NEW BUSINESS: Senior Night-Thursday, May 10th at 6:00 pm. The game is against Corcoran. We would like to do senior posters and a quad party after the game. Everyone brings something to share. **We need a junior parent to run this.** Terri Ferrigan coordinated this event last year. She has all necessary information.

END OF YEAR PICNIC: Monday, June 11th at Van Buren Park. Adrienne Rutkowski is the chairperson. We need to check the surplus from last year's picnic. Jacki Coe will look into getting donations for paper products, meat, etc. She will ask G & C Foods and a variety of other vendors.

There was a question asked about Pinnies for the Summer Camp. The boys really like to wear them for many years. Could they be a little more like the ones used for ULA?

Joe Burchill reported that Mr. Gullen and Mr. Shepard requested the Varsity schedule. They will likely film those games.
