Potomac Field Hockey – Coach Code of Conduct

Potomac Field Hockey (PFH) is focused on maintaining the spirit of field hockey sportsmanship. It is a tradition that dates back to the start of the sport, and we are determined to teach and continue those traditions within all programs we offer.

As a Coach of any PFH program, you will:

- know the rules of field hockey, and instruct players to play within these rules
- demonstrate sportsmanship and respect for the game, players, coaches, parents, umpires and officials at all times, and set expectations for your players to do the same
- remove a player who intentionally causes injury to another player, coach, umpire or official from a practice or game and report such an action to PFH
- adhere to emergency medical procedures established by PFH in the event of a medical emergency or injury, including the reporting of the emergency or injury immediately to PFH
- refuse to permit a player who is not wearing the approved uniform or safety equipment to practice or play a game
- refuse to permit a player who is not assigned to your roster to practice or play with your team
- remember that the game is played for the youth and not for you
- address any issues with a player, parent, coach, umpire, official or with PFH in an appropriate manner, at an appropriate time and in an appropriate place

You understand that you will be required during the registration process to acknowledge that you have read and agree to adhere to the Code of Conduct.

By agreeing to the above, you understand that any violation by you will result in your removal as a coach for PFH.
