New candidates for certification as a YMCA Level I Official must be at least 21 years old and be associated with a local YMCA sponsored swim team.

USA-S Certified Officials who meet age and participation requirements for Level II may go directly into Level II without first becoming a Level I Certified Official.

Candidates for re-certification must have worked at least 12 sessions as a YMCA certified official over the prior three-year certification period and present a completed Record of Meet Experience form evidencing such sessions worked.

New candidates for certification as a YMCA Level II Official must have been a fully Certified YMCA Level I Official for at least one year, have worked a minimum of eight sessions as a YMCA Certified Official and present a completed Record of Meet Experience form evidencing such sessions worked. In addition, as with Level I officials, the candidate must be at least 21 years old and be associated with a local YMCA sponsored swim team.

USA-S Certified Officials who meet age and participation requirements for Level II may go directly into Level II without first becoming a Level I Certified Official.

From Certification Clinic Instructor Regarding Level 2 - It's important that participants meet the number of sessions worked requirement. That being said, if you do have the required number of sessions, then you're qualified. Complete the meet record form with the meets you have worked (with or without referee's signatures). Sign the form on the bottom and that will be good enough. If you have worked US-S meets, you can use those to fulfill the requirement. Just print a copy of your meets worked from OTS.

The classes are posted and open for enrollment in the Learning & Career Development Center (LCDC) on [yexchange.org](http://yexchange.org). All participants who want YMCA certification must register for class through LCDC on yexchange which requires them to first set up their own LCDC profile.
