

Lightening strikes early in Canton; which leads Hartland, 14-7, when play resumes today

Lightening struck early on and around the field in Canton as Canton led Hartland 14-7 at the 6:13 minute of the first quarter before the game was postponed due to weather in a Kensington Lakes Activities Association crossover game.

Canton struck first, scoring on its first play from scrimmage when Charles Turfe ran for a 69-yard touchdown to put his team up 7-0 after just 17 second of play.

But Hartland answered right away on a Brett Oliver 90 yard kick off return for a touchdown to tie the game at 7-7 after just 30 seconds of play.

Canton scored on its ensuing drive to take the lead on a Marcus Sanders 2-yard touchdown run at the 6:40 mark of the quarter.

Turfe led Canton in rushing with 69 yards on three carries and Sanders added 17 yards on four carries. Both players had touchdowns.

Hartland's only play from scrimmage before the weather delay was a 3-yard run by Ryan McRobb.

The game was postponed due to lightening and will be continued at noon today at Canton.
