General Info

The camp will be held at Seneca High School in Tabernacle, NJ. The sessions will run for four consecutive days, June 26-29. Times will be 9:00 am – 1:00 PM Tuesday through Friday. Campers should be dropped off at 8:45 AM picked up by 1:15 PM. All campers must provide their own lunches. We will provide all the drinks.

Age of Campers

This camp is for youth between the ages of 5-15. Campers will have to be 5 years of age before the start of the camp, June 26, 2017.

Required Equipment

Each Camper should bring shorts and a t-shirt, socks, supporter, cleats, lacrosse helmet, lacrosse gloves and their stick. Each camper is responsible to have and keep their own helmet. Helmets cannot be supplied by the Golden Eagles Lacrosse Camp.

Cost

The nonrefundable fee for the entire week will be \$135. Early registration is \$125 (before the first day of camp). This fee will include camp t-shirt, instruction, onsite nurse, Gatorade, water and all camp activities.
