

WOODSIDE SPORTS COMPLEX USE AGREEMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- No person shall engage in any sale of merchandise, services or operate any concessions without prior approval.
- The Applicant must provide adequate supervision of all players on the fields. Misuse of the facility or failure to conform to the regulations will be sufficient reason to deny any future application.
- Alcoholic Beverages and/or illegal substances are prohibited on WSC property. Appropriate law enforcement agencies will be notified when violations occur and appropriate action against all involved parties will apply.
- Players are prohibited from chewing gum while on the fields. Gum may damage the surface of the field and the Applicant shall be responsible for any and all costs incurred by the WSC for proper removal of gum found on any field(s) used by Applicant.
- Players are prohibited from bringing any food onto the fields, including sunflower seeds.
- Specific prior permission is required for decorations or alterations to fixtures, walls, etc. or posting of signs for the purpose of advertising or decorating that facility or for any other purpose without first having obtained the written permission of the WSC. A reasonable charge may be assessed to remove any such items (if not promptly removed by the Applicant). Applicant shall be required to repair any damage caused by such advertising or decorations.
- No grills or cookers allowed indoors or on playing surfaces or land adjoining the playing surfaces.
- No amplifiers or devices that produce loud noises shall be permitted.
- Glass containers are prohibited in all areas.
- Pets, skates of any kind, skateboards, and bicycles are prohibited in all areas.
- Only appropriate footwear (no track spikes or track shoes that may damage the sport fields) may be used on the sport fields.
- No golf carts (excepting Woodside Sports Complex vehicles) unless or other similar motorized vehicles shall be permitted on any portion of the complex without the written approval of the WSC.
- No firearms, air rifles, BB guns, spring guns, bow and arrows, slings or any other form of weapon dangerous to human safety are allowed on the facility grounds at any time.
- It is prohibited for any person to engage in boisterous, threatening, abusive, insulting, indecent or profane language or to engage in any disorderly conduct or behavior leading to a breach of the public peace and enjoyment of the facility. The Woodside Sports Complex reserves the right to remove, or have removed, any person(s) due to abusive conduct or a non-cooperative attitude.
- No person or group shall store, leave or otherwise allow remaining at the facility, any materials, supplies, equipment or other physical accessories without written permission of the Woodside Sports Complex. A reasonable charge may be assessed by the WSC to remove any such items.
- The WSC reserves the right to remove, or have removed, any person(s) due to a violation of any of these rules.
- No smoking shall be permitted within the Woodside Sports Complex.
- Overnight parking is prohibited, including overnight parking of any motor homes or other recreational vehicle.

2015 Jamboree Rules of the Day

- **This event is a schedule of 20 minute scrimmages. Play can be stopped at any time by a coach or officials' trainer for a "teaching moment". This IS NOT a championship game of any sort. This is a fun day to get onto the lacrosse field and play and learn the game with honor and integrity.**
- **NFHS rules will apply during live ball play. Penalties will be called and assessed. As play may be stopped at any time, there are no time-outs. The 20-minute clock will run through all stoppage of play, including injuries. Please exit the field quickly to allow the next scrimmage to start on time.**
- **Game balls will be supplied by the WLF. There will be field managers around to help keep them near the end lines and sidelines. Please ask your players and fans to help keep costs down by NOT picking up the end line balls and keeping them.**
- **There is a concession stand on site. Vendors will be located near the entrance.**
- **Check in at the office in the main building.**
- **Each day there will be Great Lakes Lacrosse League games going on. Please be aware of these and stay away from the end lines while the ball is in the offensive zone.**
- **There is a \$5 gate charge for non-players/non-coaches.**
- **PCA concepts will be in play all day long.**
- **The WLF and event staff reserve that right to remove any person(s) for violations of sportsmanship and safety.**
