Code of Conduct

As an all-volunteer sports organization, GAL relies upon the willingness of adults to run the programs. In order to assure the organization remains a high quality league in which all participants are able to depend for their softball enjoyment, each parent volunteer must commit to maintaining the following standards in their conduct throughout the operations of the league.

Each Volunteer shall:

- At all times show respect for all league participants including your team members, members of the other team, coaches, umpires, league officials and spectators.
- Uphold the objectives of the league to allow the players to have fun, teach the game of softball, promote good sportsmanship and provide a safe positive recreation environment.
- Maintain a high level of concern about the safety and potential abuse of children. GAL will not tolerate the abuse of children in any way be it physical, emotional or sexual. Each volunteer must remain alert to these potential problems and commit to avoid situations in which these problems are at risk of occurring, whether in our own case or the case of others.

I read the above code of conduct and agree to adhere to its principals in my actions as a volunteer for GAL. Failure to do so may result in my termination as a volunteer for GAL and will affect acceptance for future volunteering assignments with GAL. As a volunteer for GAL, I state and certify that I have not been convicted of a crime involving criminal sexual conduct, obscenity or criminal assault nor have I been convicted of any such offenses in any other state or against the laws of the United States. I further state and certify that I have not been terminated from a former position nor have I been the subject of any disciplinary action or investigation because of sexual exploitation, sexual abuse, sexual harassment or physical abuse by me with anyone.
