

## WJGS "Recreational" Team Selection/Divisions Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)

In an effort to be as fair and transparent as possible WJGS is implementing the following SOP to determine priority when placing players on teams at the recreational level. **Payment must be received in full before registration is complete.**

WJGS will strive to fulfill all requests but cannot guarantee the placement of any player on a particular recreational team. The following will be the order in which WJGS will determine placement of players on any particular team.

1. A **returning player** from the **previous regular WJGS spring season** has first choice to return to the same Team/Coach as that previous regular spring season.
  2. A **new player** requesting a team when the Coach has promised them a position on that team as a recruiting tool to help fill that team. Coach Verification is required and the Coach should make the Board aware of such an occurrence.
  3. A **returning player** from the **previous regular WJGS spring season** requesting a new Team/Coach
  4. A **new player (includes first-time Fall Ball 2018 player)** requesting a particular Team/Coach.
  5. A player requesting a team from a higher division (i.e. "Playing UP") with coach's approval.
- Priority will be given to all coaches' daughters to play on that coach's team.
  - Early Registration (November 16, 2017 - January 31, 2018)
    - Items 1 through 5 above apply to early registration.
    - Priority will be given in order of date and time of registration.
  - Standard Registration (February 1, 2018 - February 28, 2018)
    - Early registration takes priority over standard registration.
    - Items 1 through 5 above apply to early registrants.
    - Priority will be given in order of date and time of registration.
  - The Maximum Number of players per team will be set at 15 for all Recreational divisions.

*In the event that the process described above results in too many players on a particular team WJGS will notify all parties involved of the situation and attempt to divide the players the Following three ways:*

1. WJGS will call for a meeting with parents and coaches involved to attempt to divide the teams.
2. WJGS will set up a date and time for a Draft by the coaches for the players in question.
3. WJGS will randomly divide the players into their perspective teams.
