



Field Maintenance Do's and Don'ts

- Do not use cars/trucks to drag infields
- Do not drag mat from one field to another over turf, granite or sidewalk – please pick it up
- Do not shut down flow controls on valves
- Do not let players dig holes in outfield with cleats, it creates a tripping hazard
- After use, pull bases and put in base plugs
- Use dig out tool before setting bases and plugs
- Tarp pitching mounds after games- failure to do so may prohibit mounds from being prepped (too wet from sprinklers)
- Use push button dust control before and between games
- Please keep dugout lockups clean and organized
- Do not leave portable pitching mounds/screens on fields
- During tournaments, rake in low spots- batters boxes, pitchers landings and around bases
- Do not use Lime for chalking the fields (eye/respiratory issues); use Gypsum or line-marker product
