

## How to Qualify for a “Home Run”!

### T-ball

- Hit from a Tee, smaller field
- Players will score a HR for every ball that travels past a specified distance (below)

### 8 years & under

- Pitching machine, smaller field
- Players will score a HR for every ball that travels past a specified distance (below)

### 9 & 10 years old

- Pitching machine, larger field
- Players will score a **single point** for every ball that travels past a specified distance for their age, & **5 points** for every ball hit in the air (a “Home Run”) past the same distance

### 11 & 12 years old

- Pitching machine, larger field
- Players will score a **single point** for every ball that travels past a specified distance for their age, & **5 points** for every ball hit in the air (a “Home Run”) past the same distance

### Distance Requirements

- 5=50', 6=60', 7=70', 8=80'
- 9 = 90 feet, 10 = 105 feet
- 11=120 feet & 12 = 135 feet

\* **Age = Actual “birth age” on the day of the HR Derby**

## Awards & Prizes

**TROPHIES** will be awarded to the **top two (2) HR Hitters** in each age division (5-12).

A **TROPHY** will be awarded to the **FASTEST pitch/throw** in each age division (5-12).

## Multiple Rounds

Participants are able to purchase multiple rounds, but their home run totals will not carryover for the trophy. It will be their highest home run total for one round to qualify for the trophy in their age group.

## “New & Improved” HR Derby

Changes in registration & field set-up, plus the addition of a new “points” system gives you more chances to win the HR Derby... and more time to enjoy the Carnival!
