



Fall Ball Year-End Season

1. Time Limit 10U/12U: 1 hour 20 minutes “finish the inning.” (Or as some people call it – no new inning) Simply put, once the time is up and if the home team is batting and ahead in score, the game is over. If the visiting team is at bat, they finish the inning. International tie breaker rule applies.
2. Home team is higher seed all the way through the tournament until the championship game in which the team from the winner’s bracket will be home team and **there is no time limit for championship game.**
3. In case of tie: International tie breaker applies. Last batted out is at 2nd with no outs. Next batter who is in the lineup after the runner at 2nd is up.
4. Double elimination with the exception of winner take all for championship games (due to light constraints).
5. All team will receive an MVP medal to give to the opponent’s player chosen by the players. Trophies will be awarded for 1st-3rd in 10U-12U divisions.
6. 12U will have two patch umps at the championship game.
7. All umpire decisions are final (no protests).
8. Seeding calculated by: P1-percent (wins/games), P2-Head to Head Tied Team A beat tied Team B before, P3-runs against
9. **ZERO tolerance for negative behavior.** Only the head coach may address the umpire. Coaches are responsible for their players/parents conduct.
10. Plate umpire is the official timekeeper.
11. No infield practices are permitted. No between innings warm ups for the fielders and 3 pitches for the pitchers (known as the 1 minute rule between innings).
12. Players and coaches/managers are the only ones allowed in the team dugouts.
13. The Team listed on TOP of the “Pairings” (Bracket) will establish the 1ST base dugout, unless one of the teams has back-to-back games on same field (keep the same dugout).
14. Teams must be ready to play within 30 mins of posted game times.
15. **Regardless** of home/away, when hosting, Wasco will prep field.
16. **Slaughter rule:** 12 after 3 innings, 10 after 4 innings, 8 after 5innings.

Misc: Verhaeghe has full concessions. Poynor does not. WGFSL is not responsible for vehicular damage. If at Verhaeghe, MVP medals and game balls will be delivered. If at Poynor, MVP medals and game balls (2 per game) are in field box #2. Trophies will be delivered to both fields.
