Jay Gallagher Memorial Scholarship Criteria Statement

Establishment

This award, established on July 25, 2016 by the Loudoun Junior Golf Association (LJGA) Board of Directors, is established to honour the memory of John Carlton "Jay" Gallagher. As a member of the LJGA, Jay exemplified the ideals of the organization by always playing the game competitively and for fun – at the same time.

Criteria

1. Applicant must have played in LJGA for a minimum of two years with at least one of those years being in the Masters Division.
2. Applicant must be an active member of LJGA during the year of application.
3. Applicant must be a High School graduate or graduating senior and be admitted to a four year or two year College, University, Institution, or Trade School. Documentation of acceptance is required.
4. Applicant must submit a completed Award Application by August 15, 2018 – page 2 below. The submission date will be adjusted annually to coincide with the end of tournament play.

Selection

The LJGA Board of Directors will appoint an annual committee of four composed of Board Members and representatives of the Gallagher family to review applicants. The committee will select a recipient and the decision of the committee will be final.

Award

1. This award, in the amount of \$1000.00, will be given once annually and announced at the annual End of Season Banquet.
2. Additional awards of equal or lesser amounts may be given at the LJGA's discretion.
3. The award will be made to the recipient one time and is not renewable.
4. The award will be paid through the Cashier's Office of the recipient's selected College, University, or Institution and will be credited toward tuition payments. The recipient's student ID Number must be provided to the LJGA in order to process the award.
