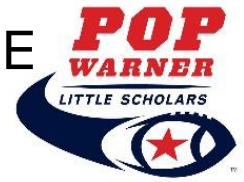

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA CONFERENCE YOUTH FOOTBALL & CHEER FIELD USE POLICY AND VISITOR EXPECTATIONS

We ask that all participants and spectators to respect the community surrounding the high school and fields used and refrain from negatively engaging community members, parking unlawfully or engaging in inappropriate behavior including but not limited to loud music from vehicles and/or smoking and drinking in residential areas, loitering or tailgating.

1. No outside food or beverage is permitted at host sites. No Coolers, cooler bags etc. (Water/Team Snacks and/or ½ time oranges will be permitted but must be checked in prior with Field commissioner) No Gatorade or sports drinks are allowed on the field. Water is allowed in secure containers.

2. There is no tailgating allowed. No BBQ's, grilling or cooking is allowed on field / school property or parking lots. Loitering is not allowed in the interior and exterior campus including parking lots. All participants and spectators must remain in the stadium during designated game times.

3. All bags / purses or cases are subject to search for the safety and welfare of the participants. Any weapons are a violation of California Education Code and will subject any participant to immediate arrest and immediate banning of membership to the SCC. All infractions will require police reporting, intervention and individuals will be banned from future SCC events and activities.

4. No Smoking of any kind is permitted. All tobacco and vaporizers are prohibited under California Education Codes and will not be tolerated in any form. While recreational use of Marijuana has been adopted under state law it is illegal to smoke within a 1000 foot distance of a school, day care center, youth center while children are present. Spectators found smoking tobacco or marijuana on school premises will be removed immediately. All infractions will require police reporting and intervention. Participants found to be smoking legally or illegally within age / venue requirements will be suspended pending further sanctions.

5. Alcohol is not permitted and is a violation of California Education Code and will not be tolerated. All infractions will require police reporting and intervention. Participants found to be drinking alcohol will be suspended pending further sanctions.

6. No sunflower seeds, nuts with shells or gum are allowed in the stadium. All items seen will be confiscated and removed.

7. No bicycles, skateboards and scooters are allowed on school grounds including but not limited to the interior, exterior and parking lots of the high school campus.

8. NO PARENTS, PLAYERS OR SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED TO ENTER SCHOOL BUILDINGS FOR ANY REASON, UNLESS EXPRESSLY PERMITTED BY MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL. NO PERSONS ARE ALLOWED TO LOITER IN THE INTERIOR OF CAMPUS OR NEAR SCHOOL BUILDING DURING SCHEDULED USE OF THE FIELD.

9. ALL CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES. NO CHILDREN ARE ALLOWED TO BE UNSUPERVISED IN THE INTERIOR OF THE CAMPUS. NO PLAY IS PERMITTED ON OR UNDER BLEACHERS, SEATING AREAS, BACK FIELDS, ADJACENT FIELD SPACE AND/OR END ZONE AREAS DURING CONTESTS. ALL SPECTATORS MUST BE WITHIN GRANDSTAND AND DESIGNATED AREAS OF USE. CHILDREN FOUND UNATTENDED WILL BE HELD WITH SCC / CHARTER PERSONNEL UNTIL PARENTS ARE NOTIFIED.

10. No animals of any kind are permitted on school properties by law. There are not designated areas for animals. All animals must be taken off campus. The exception are licensed guide dogs.

All trash / debris and/or materials are the responsibility of the users and must be cleaned after contests. We encourage all spectators to carry out trash to designated cans and receptacles.

Parents / Players and Spectators not following LOCAL SCC, Pop Warner behavioral expectations will be removed from the site immediately.

Any refusal to comply with the requests of Pop Warner personnel in any form will result in the immediate notification to the Local Police Department. All participants and spectators are subject to these rules and no exemptions or exceptions have been made as a result of the use of the field or its affiliation.
