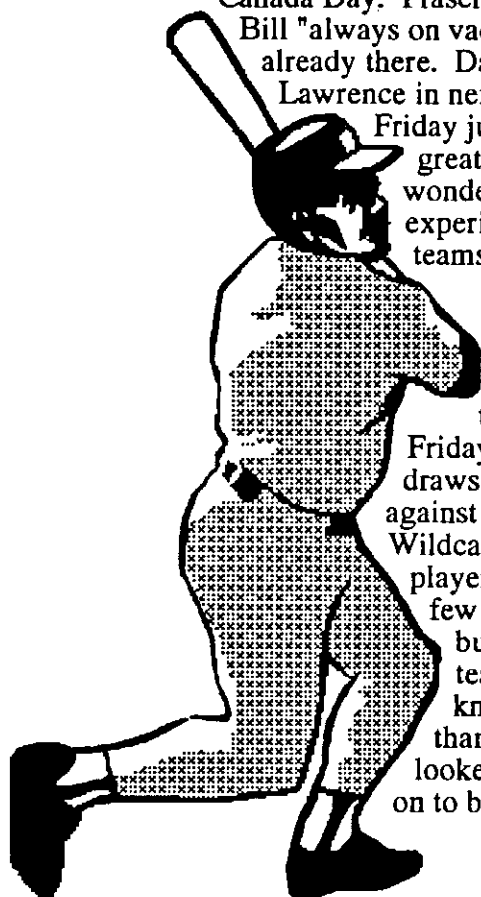


# WESA TAKES SILVER

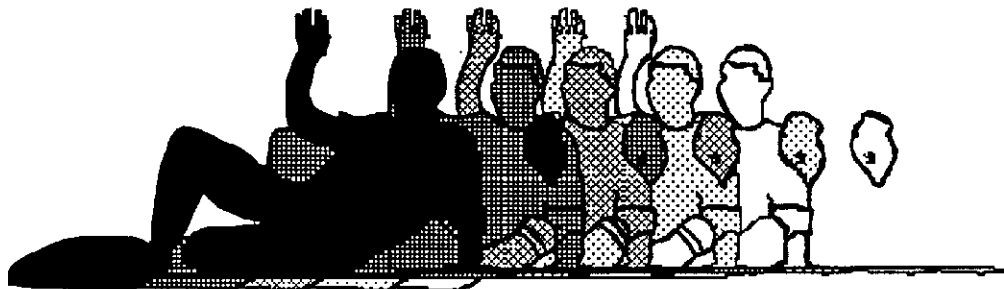

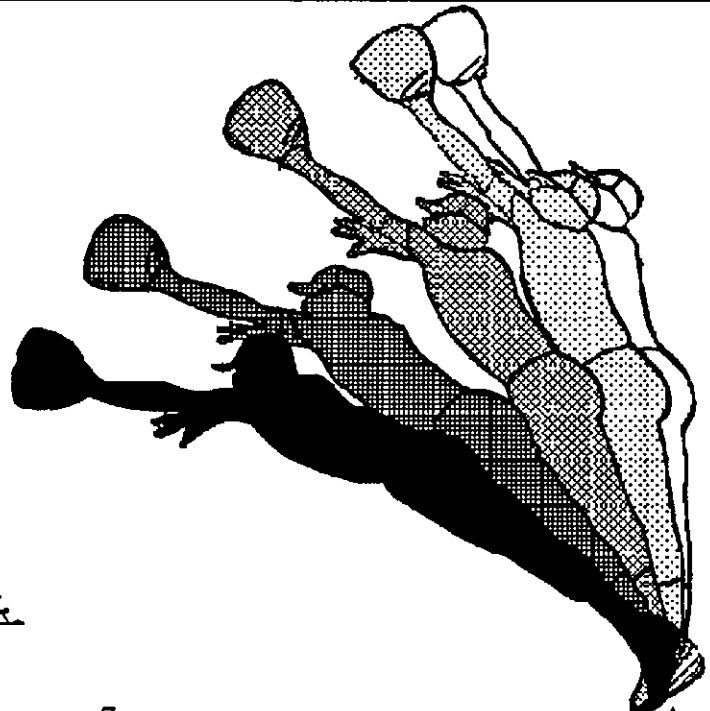
