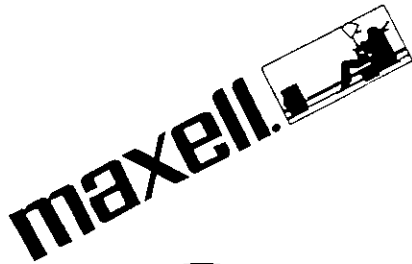

Most importantly, I hope everyone is having fun playing ball so far this season! After all that's what we're here for; the sport, the comraderie, the friendly competition and the fun.


Up-to-date stats are included in this newsletter and I know they've already been read so let's not deny that there's a teensy bit of competitiveness in all of us.

The season has finally started and well underway. Our next big event is the 10th Miss W.E.S.A. Pageant on Saturday July 22 at Celebrities. The program is as follows:


- 7:00 P.M. Doors Open - No cover charge - but "Donations" accepted.

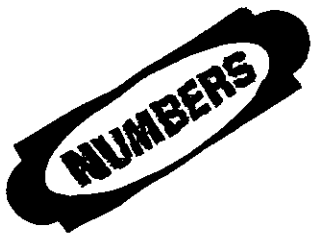

1995 WESA Membership Update

The 1995 membership drive was launched in February of 1995.
