PACIFIC CUP 1998 RULES and REGULATIONS

- TEAM'S MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF 9 PLAYERS TO START EACH GAME
- EXTRA HITTER (11TH PLAYER) MAY BE USED ON OFFENSE.
- TIME LIMIT IS NO NEW INNING TO START AFTER 65 MINUTES.
- TWO COURTESY RUNNERS ALLOWED PER INNING (LAST AVAILABLE BATTER).
- 10 RUN MERCY RULE AFTER 5 INNINGS.
- 5 RUN MAXIMUM PER INNING.
- HOME TEAM WILL BE DECIDED BY COIN TOSS PRIOR TO GAME START.
- HOME TEAM TO PROVIDE OFFICIAL SCORE KEEPER.
- PLAYERS *MUST* SLIDE OR PEEL OFF ON POTENTIAL TAG PLAYS
- SATURDAY TIES WILL STAND.
- ON SUNDAY, IF A GAME IS STILL TIED AT THE END OF TIME LIMIT, INTERNATIONAL TIE- BREAKING RULES WILL APPLY: THE LAST OUT FROM THE PERVIOUS INNING WILL BE PLACED AT SECOND BASE. EACH TEAM TAKES A TURN AT BATTING WITH FULL INNINGS UNDER THIS SITUATION UNTIL THE TIE IS BROKEN.
- COMMITMENT LINE WILL BE IN EFFECT AT HOME PLATE, RUNNER'S **MUST NOT** TOUCH HOME PLATE. PLEASE SEE ATTACHED.
- NO UNSPORTSMAN-LIKE BEHAVIOR WILL BE TOLERATED TOWARDS UMPIRES OR OTHER PLAYERS. IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM THE GAME AT THE DISCRETION OF THE UMPIRE, AND MAY RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE TOURNAMENT UPON REVIEW BY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS.
- PLAYERS MUST NOT SHOW UP TO PLAY UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS OR ALCOHOL.

PACIFIC CUP 1998

JUST A FEW RULES TO THINK ABOUT

- **COMMITMENT LINE**

- IS DRAWN 20 FEET FROM HOMEPLATE & PERPENDICULAR TO THE THIRD BASE LINE
- A BASERUNNER WHO HAS PLACED ONE FOOT OVER AND ON THE GROUND PAST THE COMMITMENT LINE MUST CONTINUE ON TOWARDS THE SCORING LINE (AT HOME PLATE). A PLAYER WHO HAS TOUCHED AND/OR CROSSED OVER THE COMMITMENT LINE AND ATTEMPTS TO RETURN TO THIRD BASE, SHALL BE DECLARED OUT.

- **SCORING LINE**

- IS DRAWN FROM THE CORNER OF HOMEPLATE & PERPENDICULAR TO THE THIRD BASE LINE
- ALL BASERUNNERS ATTEMPTING TO REACH HOMEPLATE MUST DO SO BY TOUCHING AND/OR CROSSING THE SCORING LINE IN FOUL TERRITORY, AND MUST HAVE AT LEAST ONE FOOT COMPLETELY OVER AND ON THE GROUND PAST THE LINE IN ORDER FOR THE RUN TO COUNT. IF A DEFENSIVE PLAYER HAS CONTROL OF THE BALL AND IS TOUCHING HOMEPLATE BEFORE THE RUNNER TOUCHES AND/OR CROSSES THE SCORING LINE, THE BASERUNNER IS OUT.

- **RUNNERS ARE OUT IF THEY TOUCH HOMEPLATE**

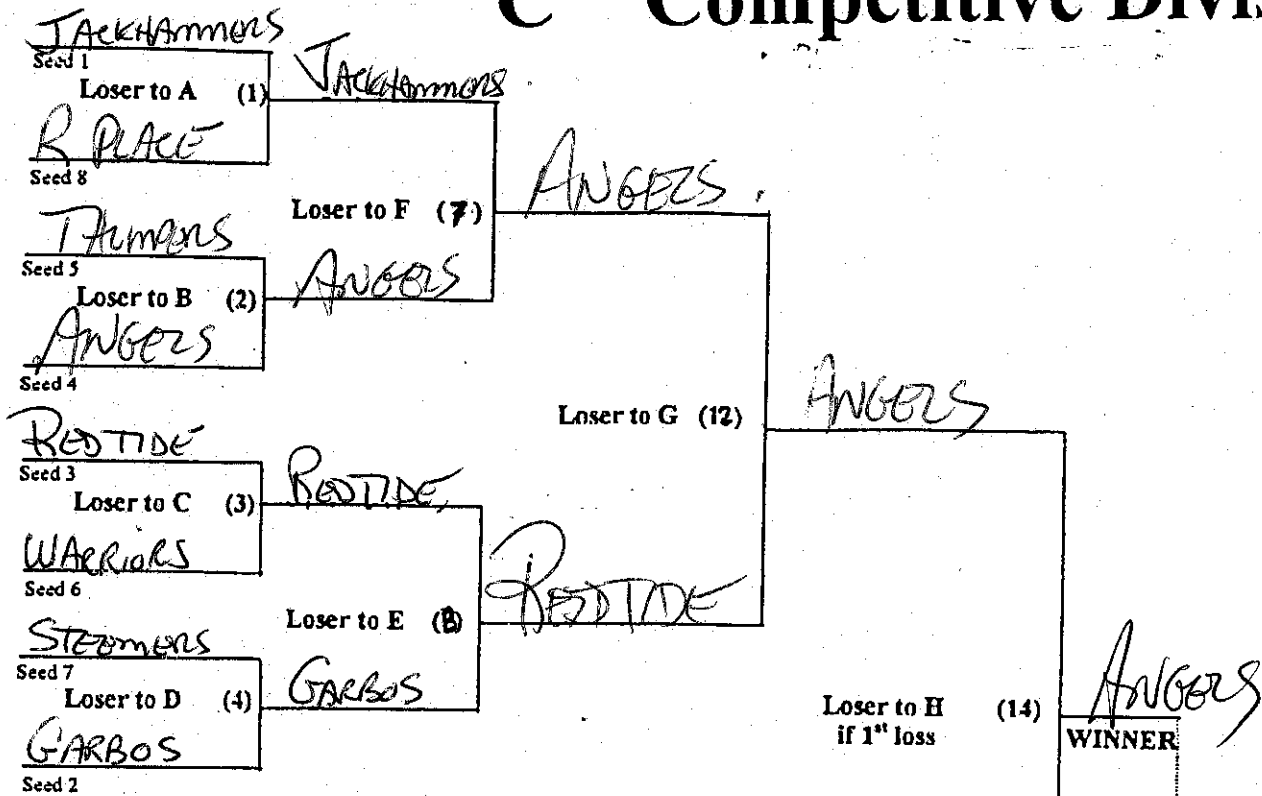
- **A BASERUNNER MAY BE TAGGED OUT BETWEEN THE COMMITMENT LINE AND THE SCORING LINE**



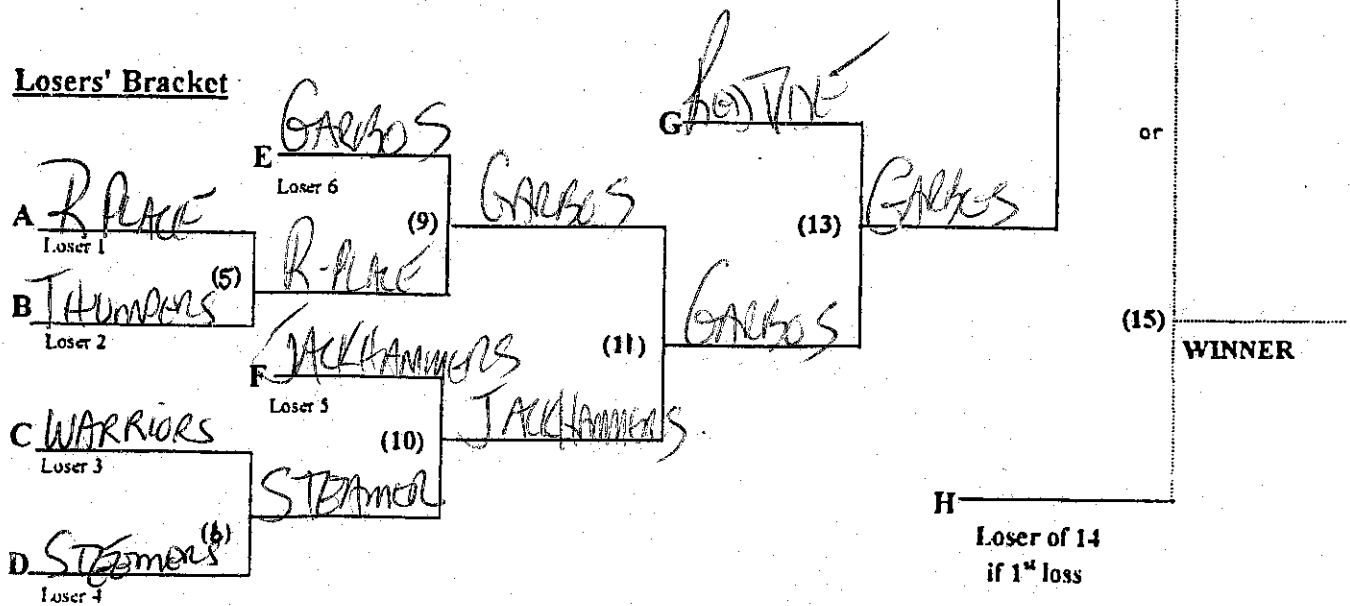

Winners' Bracket



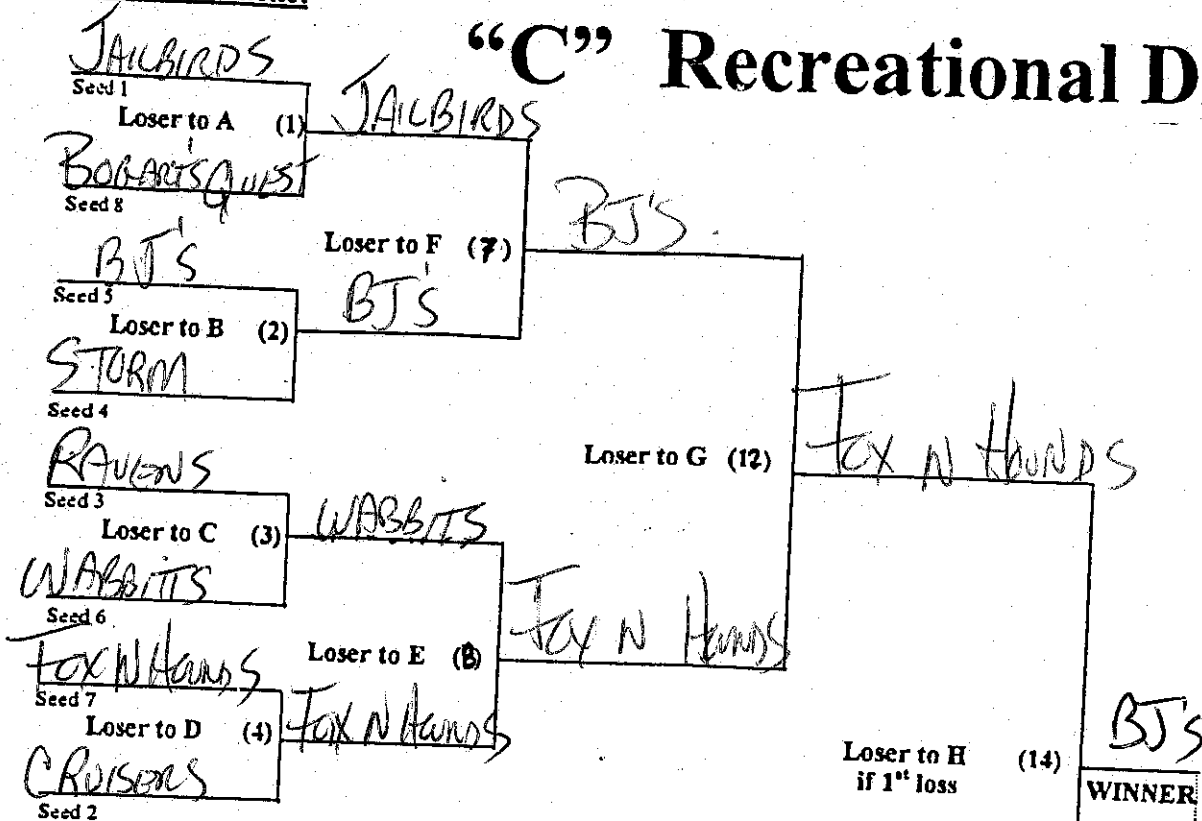
Losers' Bracket



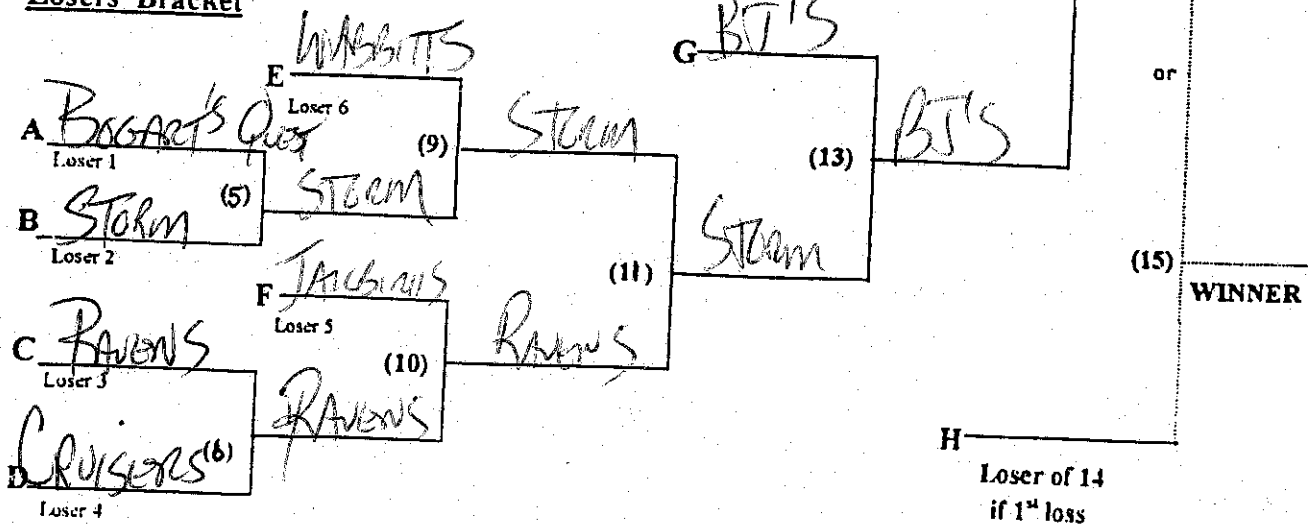

Winners' Bracket

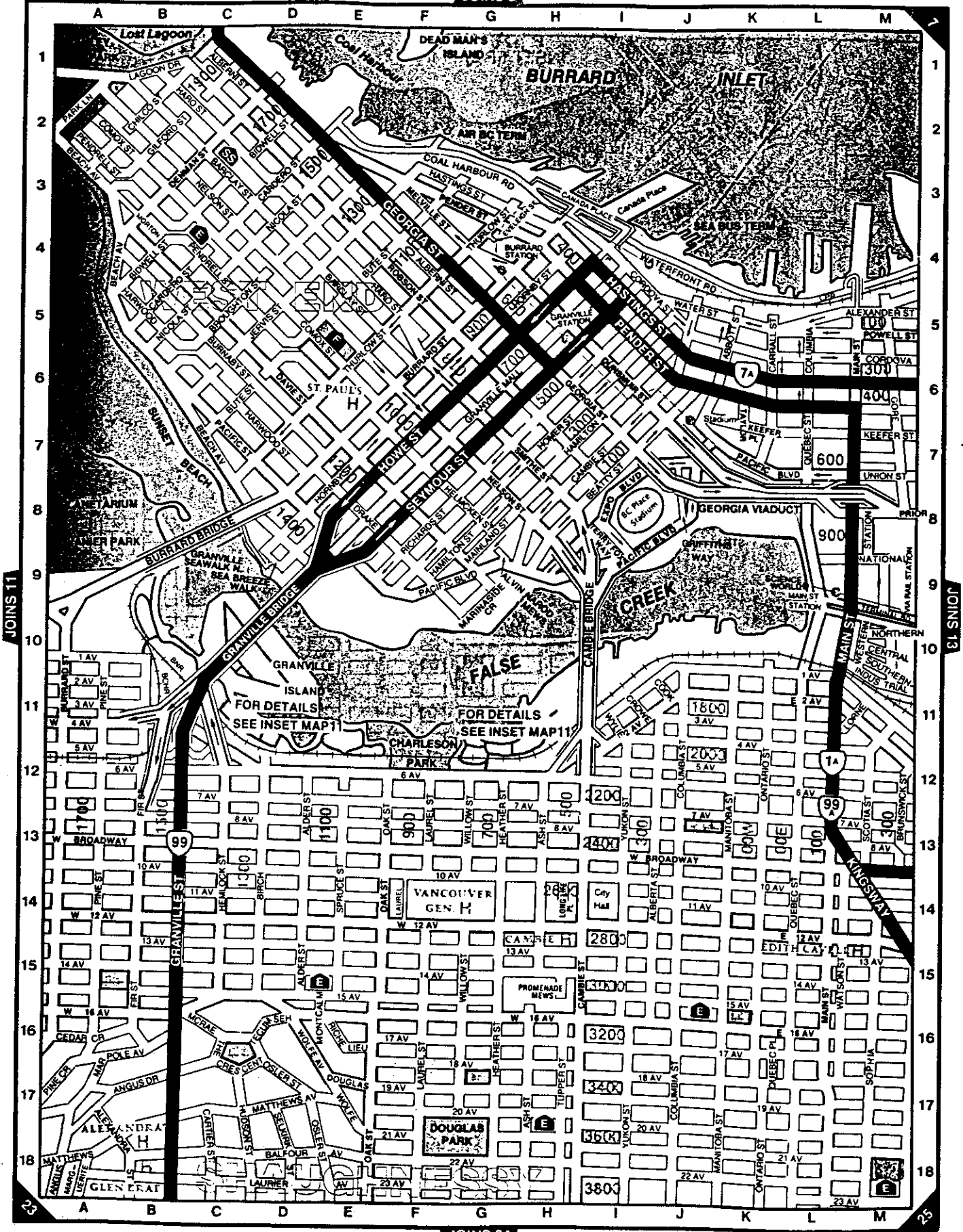


Losers' Bracket
