SECYH Evaluation Criteria

Evaluations shall consist of skill evaluation in the areas of skating, passing and receiving a pass, stick handling, shooting, play making, stamina, and checking (Bantam/Midget as applicable). Goaltenders will be also evaluated based on their proficiency in positional play, balance, lateral movement, agility/reflexes, recovery, leadership, work ethic and controlling rebounds. .

Players will also be evaluated in scrimmage or game situations to determine positional play and competitiveness. Players will be evaluated by adults knowledgeable in the game of hockey. The evaluation will be conducted by independent evaluators either as a paid resource or volunteers.

To ensure fairness, all players will be evaluated during the course of the ongoing season by the team coaches and, additionally, by evaluators during the player evaluations, to determine a player's level of skill and competence during game play. The coach's pre-evaluation scores will be used as an additional tool during the season ending evaluation process. The final evaluation scores will be provided to the Division Director. The list will be reviewed between the Division Directors, evaluators, and selected members of the Board of Directors and, if already identified, the head coach of the respective team that the players will be assigned to play on during the upcoming season. The team selection should be based on the total evaluation scores unless there is an underlying reason why a player may not be considered to be as highly rated as the scores indicate or if the scores do not accurately reflect the player's skills, attitude and behavior demonstrated during the recent season.

If there is more than one team in each division the higher rated team (A team) will have a lesser number of players. This is done to take into account new players joining the organization or the development of a player over the course of the off season. Once the new season starts the players on the B and / or C team may be evaluated in order to determine if there is any players should be moved up to the A or B team.

Once the players have been assigned to a team, the Division Director will contact the parents to inform them of the player's team assignments. Parents must complete the registration on the SECYH web site which includes the commitment statement and initial registration fee within five days of notification by the Division Director. Failure to do so may result in withdrawal of the offer for placement on the team. The initial tuition payment (first instalment) must be paid in advance of the first practice of the new season.
