Club Directors

Boys Coaching Director

Responsible for directing all player development programs and providing guidance to best practices for coaching, player development, and communicating lacrosse knowledge across all age levels of the boys program.

Girls Coaching Director

Responsible for directing all player development programs and providing guidance to best practices for coaching, player development, and communicating lacrosse knowledge across all age levels of the girls program.

Equipment Director

Responsible to purchase, maintain, organize, and update equipment including goals, nets, and other team equipment. Manages the distribution and collection of coaches' bags and equipment.

Events Director

Extends invitations to other clubs for Jamboree, alerts volunteer coordinator to volunteer needs (field lining, etc).

Team Level

Head Coach

The Head Coach will instruct & train athletes on fundamentals of lacrosse. Establish practice times and communicate to team. Prepare practice plans and share with assistant coaches. Provide a safe, fun, and educational environment for all players.

Assistant Coach

One of the most important roles for the Assistant Coach is supporting the head coach. Some Assistant Coaches have direct coaching responsibilities, while others only respond to a main or head coach's directives. Assistant coaches assist in the preparation, planning, and evaluation of practice sessions as directed. Support the BSL mission to emphasize the development of skills, self-esteem, good sportsmanship, and teamwork through the sport of lacrosse.

Team Manager

The Team Manager is responsible for the off field administration for the team. Must have excellent communication skills. The manager is responsible for communication to parents regarding practices, games, and anything else as directed by the coaches.
