LAWN BOWLING PROCEDURES AND RULES

THREE DIFFERENT LAWN BOWLING GAMES:

GAME 1: ONE PLAYER VS ONE PLAYER

GAME 2: TWO PLAYERS VS TWO PLAYERS

GAME 3: THREE PLAYERS (Lead-Vice-Skip) VS THREE PLAYERS (Lead-Vice-Skip)

GAME PROCEDURE:

- 1) THE LEADS FLIP A COIN; THE WINNER DECIDES TO GO 1ST OR 2ND.
- 2) THE LEAD GOING FIRST THROWS THE JACK UNTIL THE JACK PASSES THE HALF WAY POINT.
- 3) THE SAME LEAD FOLLOWS BY THROWING THEIR FIRST LAWN BOWL, FOLLOWED BY THE OPPONENT LEAD.
- 4) AFTER ALL 6 LAWN BOWLS HAVE BEEN THROWN, THE VICES THROW THEIR 6 LAWN BOWLS, FOLLOWED BY THE SKIPS.
- 5) ANY BOWLS THAT ARE THROWN OUT OF BOUNDS OR NOT THROWN BEYOND THE MIDWAY POINT WILL RESULT IN THE PLAYERS LOSING THAT TURN.
- 6) AFTER ALL SIX PLAYERS HAVE THROWN THEIR LAWN BOWLS, EVERYONE EXCEPT FOR THE TWO SKIPS MUST WALK TO THE OPPOSITE END.
- 7) THE TWO SKIPS WILL DECIDE WHO IS SCORING. THE SKIP THAT IS SCORING WILL TELL THE OTHER SKIP HOW MANY POINTS HE/SHE HAS. IF THE SKIP NOT SCORING

AGREES, THEY BOTH LOG THE SCORE IN THEIR PADS. SKIPS MUST WRITE THE SCORE ON THE SCOREBOARD.

8) THE SKIP THAT IS COUNTING SHOWS THE OTHER SKIP THEIR 1ST BALL THAT IS COUNTED. HE/SHE THEN REMOVES THE BALL TO AN OPEN AREA AND CHECKS TO SEE WHO IS COUNTING SECOND. IF IT'S THE SAME SKIP THAT IS COUNTING, HE/SHE SHOWS THE OTHER SKIP. IF THE OTHER SKIP AGREES, HE/SHE MOVES THE BALL. IF HE/SHE ONLY HAS TWO POINTS THE OTHER SKIP MUST AGREE. THEY THEN MUST LOG THE SCORE IN THEIR PADS. THEY DO THIS AT EVERY END.

9) THE LEAD NOT SCORING WILL GATHER THE LAWN BOWLS AND WILL THROW THE JACK FIRST AND THE LAWN BOWL SECOND. THE LEAD-VICE-SKIPS WILL ROTATE.

IMPORTANT:

- WHILE PLAYING EACH END, ANYONE HITTING THE JACK OUT OF BOUNDS, TEAMS DO NOT SCORE.
- THE GAME LIMIT IS AN HOUR AND A HALF. TEAMS MAY FINISH THE END THEY ARE PLAYING.
- GAMES CAN BE PLAYED WITH MENS, WOMENS, AND COED TEAMS. TEAMS MAY CHANGE ONE MALE OR ONE FEMALE DURING THE GAME.
