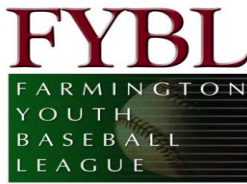

<p>All American, National, AAA and Minors and Majors Softball players must attend the appropriate try-out session (details & times will be available at registration and will be posted on FYBL.org).</p> <p>* Players who played in American Division must try out for team placement purposes only.</p> <p><i>Note: The league reserves the right to place each player at a level appropriate to his or her abilities or by age.</i></p>			

T-Ball/A-Ball T-Ball is an instructional program for 5 and 6 year old boys and girls. (Must be 5 years of age as of April 30, 2011.) New teams are formed each year by managers. A-Ball is a modified coach pitch for second year T-Ball players. Games typically are played on Saturdays at the Little League Fields. Managers will contact their assigned players. Teams are typically formed according to neighborhood residence and school attendance.

AA (Coach Pitch) A level established primarily for 6-8 year old boys and girls. Emphasis is on learning the fundamentals of baseball, excluding pitching. Games typically are played on Saturdays at the Little League Fields. Following a draft in March, managers will contact selected players. Teams are typically formed according to neighborhood residence and school attendance

AAA (Minors) A competitive live pitching level for boys and girls between 7-10 years of age who do not have the experience to play the National or American level. Teams are determined by draft based on tryout ratings of independent evaluators. Games typically are played on Thursdays and Saturdays at the Little League Fields. Managers will contact selected players after the National and American teams have been formed.

National (Minors) A level for the more experienced 8-12 year old boys and girls. Teams are determined by a draft based on tryout ratings of independent evaluators. Games typically are played on Tuesdays and Saturdays at the Little League fields. Following a draft in March, managers will contact selected players. **12 year olds are not allowed to pitch at the National League level.**

American (Majors) A level for the more experienced 9-12 year old boys and girls. **You must play at least one year at the AAA level or National level before trying out for American.** Teams are determined by a draft based on tryout ratings of managers. Games typically are played on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays at the Little League fields. Following the draft in March, managers will contact selected players. Players who turn 13 on or before April 30, 2011 are not eligible for Little League.

Softball This program is designed for Little League girls of ages 7-12 (age determined as of December 31, 2011). **Coach Pitch** is for ages 7-8. **Minors** level places emphasis on learning the fundamentals, typically for ages 8-10. **Majors** level includes competitive play and live pitching, typically for ages 10-12. Player placement and teams are determined at the Spring Try Outs in March.

VOLUNTEER POLICY

Farmington Little League operates solely on the volunteer efforts of players’ family members and other community members. Board members, managers, coaches, etc., **are not compensated in any way.** Without the support of people like you, the league would not be able to offer young people the opportunity to learn skills and enjoy the games of baseball or softball.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I, the parent/guardian of the above-named candidate (“my child”) for a position on the Farmington Youth Baseball League team, do hereby give approval for my child to participate in any and all Little League activities – including transportation to and from the activities. I know that participation in baseball may result in serious injury to my child and that protective equipment does not prevent all injuries to players, and do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless Farmington Youth Baseball League, Little League Baseball Incorporated, and all officers, sponsors, employees, managers, coaches and other volunteers from any claim, demand or cause of injury to my child or damage to his/her personal property which arises out of or in any way is connected to Farmington Youth Baseball League programs or any travel required for such programs – whether the result of negligence or for any other cause. I will furnish a birth certificate for my child for verification by league officials upon request. I certify that my child resides within the Town of Farmington. If requested, I agree to provide proof of residency as defined by Farmington Youth Baseball League. I understand that my child will not be permitted to participate in Farmington Youth Baseball League should it be determined that he/she does not reside within the Town of Farmington. I agree, individually and on behalf of my child, to submit all disputes to binding arbitration before the American Arbitration Association. In doing this, I specifically waive any right to trial by jury for any reason.
