Player Legal Release Form

R e l e a s e o f L i a b i l i t y

I, the parent/guardian of the above-named candidate (“my child”) for a position on the Farmington Little League team, do hereby give approval for my child to participate in any and all Little League activities – including transportation to and from the activities. I know that participation in baseball may result in serious injury to my child and that protective equipment does not prevent all injuries to players, and do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless Farmington Little League, Little League Baseball Incorporated, and all officers, sponsors, employees, managers, coaches and other volunteers from any claim, demand or cause of injury to my child or damage to his/her personal property which arises out of or in any way is connected to Farmington Little League programs or any travel required for such programs – whether the result of negligence or for any other cause. I will furnish a birth certificate for my child for verification by league officials upon request. I certify that my child resides within the Town of Farmington. If requested, I agree to provide proof of residency as defined by Farmington Little League. I understand that my child will not be permitted to participate in Farmington Little League should it be determined that he/she does not meet the residency requirements of Farmington Little League. I agree, individually and on behalf of my child, to submit all disputes to binding arbitration before the American Arbitration Association. In doing this, I specifically waive any right to trial by jury for any reason.

I HAVE READ THE ABOVE APPLICATION AND AGREEMENTS AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE ASSUMED ALL RISKS FOR ANY INJURIES SUSTAINED BY MY CHILD.

By registering your child to participate in Farmington Little League, you are expressly waiving any objection to having your child photographed/ or taken on video at any event involving Farmington Little League. 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Description of Leagues

T-Ball

T-Ball is an instructional program for boys and girls 4-6 years old. All 4 year olds must play tee ball. Games typically are played on Saturdays and Sundays at the Little League Fields, with one scheduled practice per week. Teams are co-ed and typically formed according to neighborhood residence and school attendance. Managers will contact players in late March.

BASEBALL	SOFTBALL
<p>Coach Pitch A level established primarily for 5-8 year olds. 5 and 6 year olds are permitted to play “coach Pitch”, if they have played one year of T-Ball. Emphasis is on learning the fundamentals of baseball, excluding pitching. Games typically are played on Saturdays and Saturdays at the Little League Fields, with one scheduled practice per week. Teams are typically formed according to neighborhood residence and school attendance. Managers will contact players in late March.</p>	<p>Minors - Coach Pitch <i>Coach Pitch/A-</i> A level established primarily for 5-8 year olds. Emphasis is on learning the fundamentals of softball, excluding pitching. Managers will contact players in late March. Girls who are Little League Softball Age 5 may participate in the Coach Pitch Division if they played in the Farmington Little League T-Ball or Coach Pitch Division in the 2017 Spring season. Usually 6 home games at Baily field and 6 away games. <i>(Out-of-town games will likely be played in- Avon, Bristol, Canton, Burlington, and Simsbury)</i></p>
<p>Machine Pitch A competitive level for those between 7-10 years of age who do not have the experience to play the National or American level. A spring loaded (“machine”) pitching device is used. Kids will not pitch in this league. Teams are determined by a draft based on an independent evaluation at tryouts. Most games are played on Thursdays and Saturdays, but some games will be scheduled on other days. There will also be one scheduled practice per week. Following a draft in March, managers will contact selected players. TRY-OUT REQUIRED.</p>	<p>Minors – Coach / Girls Pitch <i>Minors / AA-</i> A level established primarily for 7-10 year olds. Emphasis is on learning the fundamentals of softball, including pitching. Managers will contact players in late March. EVALUATION REQUIRED. Usually 6 home games at Baily field and 6 away games. <i>(Out-of-town games will likely be played in- Avon, Bristol, Canton, Burlington, and Simsbury)</i></p>
<p>Minors A competitive live pitching level for the more experienced 8-11 year olds. Teams are determined by a draft based on an independent evaluation at tryouts. Most games are played on Tuesdays and Saturdays, but some games will be scheduled on other days. There will also be one scheduled practice per week. Following a draft in March, managers will contact selected players. TRY-OUT REQUIRED.</p>	<p>Minors – Girls Pitch <i>Minors/AAA-</i> A level established primarily for 7-12 year olds. This level is a competitive live pitching level with emphasis on learning and executing the finer points of softball. EVALUATION REQUIRED. Usually 6 home games at Baily field and 6 away games. <i>(Out-of-town games will likely be played in- Avon, Bristol, Canton, Burlington, and Simsbury)</i></p>
<p>Majors A level for the most experienced 10-12 year olds. You must play at least one year at the AAA level or National level before trying out for American. Teams are determined by a draft based on an independent evaluation at tryouts. Games typically are played on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays at the Little League fields. Following the draft in March, managers will contact selected players. TRY-OUT REQUIRED.</p>	<p>Majors Majors- A level established primarily for 9-12 year olds. This level includes competitive play and live pitching. Player placement and teams are determined after the draft in March. EVALUATION REQUIRED. Usually 6 home games at Baily field and 6 away games. <i>(Out-of-town games will likely be played in- Avon, Bristol, Canton, Burlington, and Simsbury)</i></p>
<p>Junior & Senior League Junior league is a level for 13 – 14 year olds. Senior league is a level for 13 – 16 year olds. Teams will be chosen in March. Games will be played against other teams in Farmington Little League, but also teams in District 5 (Berlin, Wallingford, Bristol, etc.). TRY-OUT MAY BE REQUIRED.</p>	<p>Junior & Senior League Junior league is a level for 13 – 14 year olds. Senior league is a level for 13 – 16 year olds. Teams will be chosen in March. Games will be played against teams in District 5 and 6 (Avon, Simsbury, Berlin, Wallingford, Bristol, etc.). EVALUATION REQUIRED.</p>
<p>All Baseball and Softball Majors, Baseball and Softball Minors (except Minors Coach Pitch Softball), and Baseball Machine Pitch must attend the appropriate try-out session (details & times will be available after registration and will be posted on www.FYBL.org. Players who played in Majors Baseball and Majors Softball last year must try out for team placement purposes.</p>
