Dear Little League Baseball Parents,

Queen Anne Little League is preparing for the 2018 All-Star Tournament selection process. All players who are league age 9-14, who have played in at least 60% of the regular scheduled games for the 2018 spring baseball/softball season, are eligible to apply for All Stars.

Please complete the Commitment form below and return it to Nick Ring's attention (nring11@gmail.com) by May 7th. Commitments received after May 7th may impact eligibility. For more information on the selection process and dates, please see the QALL website at [www.qall.org/All-Stars](http://www.qall.org/All-Stars).

The time commitment to All Stars is considerable, with teams practicing up to 6 days a week prior to the start of the tournament and will continue through until the team is eliminated from tournament play. The expectation is that all players will make each practice and game and attending the warm-up tournament is required. If you are aware of dates your child will miss, please make note of that below.

The timing for the All Star Teams announcement will occur on the evening of June 9. Practices will begin immediately and there will be a BBQ for All-Star players and their families on Sunday, June 10. For baseball 9/10's, 10/11's, and 11/12's there will also be a warm-up tournament June 15-17. The tournament dates are approximately the following for baseball: 9/10s start on June 23, 10/11s start on June 30 and 11/12s start on July 7. All the tournaments could go for up to 10 days depending on the team's success.

If a QALL baseball team is fortunate enough to win Districts, the State tournaments start on July 7 for the 9/10s, July 14 for the 10/11s and July 21 for the 11/12s.

All players chosen for an All-Star team must provide a valid certified copy of a birth certificate (original document, not a copy) and also provide three or more documents out of the 17 accepted by Little League Baseball to determine residency of the parent or guardian. All proof of residency must be dated **prior** to February 1, 2018 with the exception of driver licenses. See below for the list of valid proofs.

Beginning with the 2017 season, the following changes will be implemented for the **Residency and School Attendance Eligibility Requirements:**

• A school issued report card or performance record will no longer be accepted to establish school attendance. Either **the [school enrollment form](#)** or an **official/certified school enrollment record dated prior to October 1, 2017** can be used to establish school attendance for the 2018 season.

• Also, [residence](#) shall be established and supported by documents containing the full residence which includes parent(s) or guardian(s) name, street address, city, state and zip code information, dated or in force between February 1, 2017 (previous year) and February 1, 2018 (current year), from one or more documents from EACH of the three Groups outlined below:

**Group I**

1. Driver's License (photo ID of parent(s) or guardian(s) with qualifying residence address)
2. School records (home address of player's parents or guardians)
3. Vehicle records (i.e., registration, lease, etc.)
4. Employment records
5. Insurance documents (with residence address)

**Group II**

1. Welfare/child care records
2. Federal records (i.e., Federal Tax, Social Security, etc.)
3. State records
4. Local (municipal) records
5. Support payment records
6. Homeowner or tenant records
7. Military records

**Group III**

1. Voter's Registration
2. Utility bills (i.e., - gas, electric, water/sewer, phone, mobile phone, heating, waste disposal)
3. Financial records (loan, credit, investments, etc.)
4. Medical records
5. Internet, cable, or satellite television records

**NOTE:** Example – Three documents from the same Group (utility bill, cable bill, and bank statement) constitute only **ONE** document.
