The purpose of this form is to allow students who are eligible by NCHSAA standards, but ineligible by the higher WCPSS standards, to make an appeal for a waiver of the WCPSS rules.

Terms of the Contract

The student is required to agree to abide by a contract whereby his/her academic performance and attendance would be monitored on a weekly basis as long as he/she continues to participate in the athletic or co-curricular activity. Failure to meet the conditions of the contract or to make a weekly report will require the student to miss the following week of activity (all practices, competitions, etc.).

The student must take the grade monitoring sheet to each and every teacher each Thursday or Friday. Each teacher should complete the appropriate information on one of those two days each week. The student must take the completed grade monitoring sheet to his or her coach each Friday at the end of the school day. Failure to turn in the sheet or to meet any terms of the contract will prohibit the student from participation the following week (beginning on Monday morning and ending the following Monday morning).

Details of the Conditions for the Contract for this Student

1. Student must maintain a C average with regards to nine weeks grades in each and every subject.
2. Student must have no unexcused absences in any class during the past week.
3. Once the contract is set into motion, the student can have no more than 2 weeks in which he does not meet the terms of the contract. If the student fails to meet the terms of the contract twice, the student will be dismissed from the team for the remainder of the season.
