

McDowell Equipment Assignment Agreement (17/18)

Per the McDowell Bylaws and to ensure the longevity of our quality jerseys and shells, the following rules must be adhered to:

1. Jerseys must be kept and transported to all games in the garment bag. Any garment bag that zips and encloses the jerseys is acceptable.
2. Jersey must be laundered before they are returned after the season ends.
3. At no time should a jersey be thrown on the locker room floor, wadded up or stored in an equipment bag.
4. Any jersey that gets cut or torn should be given to the team manager for repair. Any damages incurred due to misuse or from being thrown in a hockey bag will result in the skater being charged for the repairs. ALL repairs should be reported to the equipment director so repair/replacement arrangements can be made.
5. At no time should a McDowell jersey be worn for any event other than an official team function. Team functions include games or any public event attended as a team, such as parades, walk-a-thons, etc. Game jerseys will not be worn for practices. Jerseys may not be worn to school or any other independent activity.
6. All members' families shall be responsible for the care of their skater's team jerseys, including financial reimbursement to the McDowell Hockey Club, if lost or stolen.
7. The extra game jersey/blood jersey will be the responsibility of the coach or team manager.
8. The jersey shall be returned at the end of the season and the deposit will be returned/destroyed.
9. The shell should be returned with the jersey at the end of the year.
10. Failure to return the jersey by the End of Year Banquet will result in forfeiture of deposit check.

The deposit for the home and away jerseys and the shell is **\$250**.
