Grounds Rules

The following policies are in effect whenever there are games at Cherokee:

1. No animals are permitted on school grounds. Our parents and the visiting team's parents need to be informed of this in advance of all home games.
2. Only players, coaches and game officials are permitted inside the fence of the stadium. Parents, siblings and children are to watch the games outside of the fenced area.
3. Teams are not permitted to warm up on the track surface, including high jump area. Cleats destroy the surface.
4. No cars are permitted inside the gated area at the top of the hill. Exceptions may be made on a per case basis by the school district. The request must be made in advance of game day so that arrangements may be made.
5. No smoking is permitted anywhere on school grounds.

The responsibility to enforce these policies falls on the game day coaches or any Marlton Girls Lacrosse member who may be present. Failure to adhere to the school's policies may cause us to lose the use of Cherokee.
