



THE AVENGERS BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIPS

The Avengers Booster Club awards four, one thousand dollar (\$1,000) individual scholarships and four, two-hundred-fifty dollar (\$250) scholarships to Senior Student-Athletes in recognition of their accomplishments, including showing team and school spirit during their high school career. Scholarship winners will be chosen by a panel of five judges who are not currently affiliated with the Avengers Booster Club and do not have children attending East Greenwich High School. Scholarship winners will be announced at the Annual Avengers Senior Sports Awards Banquet, held in June, which The Avengers Booster Club proudly sponsors.

Eligibility: Open to all graduating East Greenwich High School Seniors with at least a 2.5 GPA who will be attending a college, university, preparatory school, trade school or joining the military in the Fall. Students must have competed as a Varsity Athlete, been a member of a Competitive Athletic Club or have been a member of the Varsity Cheerleading Squad. Either the applicant, or a member of the applicant's family, must be a current member of The Avengers Booster Club for a minimum of two years. The scholarship application is located on goavengers.org under the "Forms" tab on the left of the home page and is available in the main office, guidance office, and athletic directors office. The application and all corresponding information must be submitted to Athletic Director, Chris Cobain by Tuesday, April 30, 2019.

Procedure:

- **Complete and sign the attached application.** Include details on your career at East Greenwich High School including participation in sports, academics, honors, awards and extracurricular activities. You may choose to attach your resume and use an additional sheet of paper, if necessary.
- **Write an essay**, up to 1,000 words, incorporating the three criteria of Leadership, Sportsmanship and Dedication. The essay should give an example of how the student athlete has exemplified these characteristics during their high school sports career.
 - **Leadership:** A process by which a person influences others to accomplish an objective and helps direct the team in a way that makes it more cohesive and coherent. Leaders carry out this process by applying their leadership attributes, such as beliefs, values, ethics, character, knowledge and skills. How have you displayed these skills with your teammates, coaches and the school as a whole?
 - **Sportsmanship:** The athlete's ability to demonstrate fair and respectful participation on his/her own team as well as an opponents team. The ability to show graciousness in both victory and defeat. Sportsmanship is a behavior and attitude that shows respect for the rules of a game and other players, as well as coaches, officials, and fans.
 - **Dedication:** Displaying loyalty to a team in both winning and losing seasons and having the ability to show dedication even in the most adverse conditions and situations. The desire to put forth 100% effort in practices and games while always being prepared to play. Going beyond what is required to improve your condition and game.
- **Include a letter of recommendation** from a coach in support of your application, stating at least one of the application criteria, and/or a defining event or moment that had a lasting impact on the coach and team.
- **Include a resume** outlining supportive information.
