Medical Attention: I hereby give my consent to **The Woodlands Lacrosse Association and The Woodlands Club** to provide, through a medical staff of its choice, customary medical/athletic training attention, transportation and emergency medical services as warranted in the course of my participation in **The Woodlands Lacrosse Play Day**.

3. Readiness to Compete: I will only participate in those competitions or activities in which I believe I am physically and psychologically prepared to participate.

The Code of Conduct

1. All Participants should play in the spirit of the game.
2. All Participants are to HONOR the game. Each person should respect the rules of the game and treat officials, opponents, teammates and coaches with respect.
3. The value of winning shall never be placed above the value of instilling the highest ideals of character.
4. The head coach shall act in a courteous manner and also shall endeavor in every way to achieve the same from players, coaches and parents.
5. One of the team's coaches shall be designated the head coach. The head coach is responsible for making all decisions for that team not delegated specifically to the team's game captain. It is the head coach's responsibility to see that players and substitutes are equipped properly, both mentally and physically, to play.
6. Coaches are responsible for controlling their players, spectators and any other persons associated with their program.
7. Abusive, profane or violent behavior or language by coaches, players or fans will not be tolerated. Behavior in this manner may result in member suspension or expulsion from the Tournament.
8. No alcoholic beverages or any intoxicating substances or intoxicated individuals are allowed.
9. A player must not conduct him/herself in a rough, dangerous or unsportsmanlike manner.
