



HIGH SCHOOL PLAYERS

INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTERING AS A YOUTH OFFICIAL FOR THE 2013-14 SEASON

If you are interested in becoming an official for youth games for the Spring Season, you need to register before October 1 as an official with WALOA, and you need to renew your US Lacrosse membership (indicating you are both a high school player and an official).

In past years, WALOA conducted the registration process in January, just before the season started. The change to Fall Registration allows for more training opportunities, and aligns the WALOA registration with the US Lacrosse registration for officials. Request a NFHS rulebook (free) during the USL registration process. (The system will indicate a backorder – this is normal.)

If you would like to be an official next Spring, go to the following site to register:

The registration fee for youth referees is \$45.

Payment can be made using a Credit Card, eCheck, or mail-in check.

In addition to your personal information, you will also be asked to provide the following additional information:

Team Affiliation: If you are a high school player, provide the team that you play for. If you are a high school official, and you have a direct connection (board, coach, etc.) to a specific program, please provide the program name.

USL Number: You are REQUIRED to enter your US Lacrosse membership number. This should be a 6 or 7-digit number. Since you also need to renew your US Lacrosse membership, you should have this number readily available from the separate US Lacrosse membership renewal process.

WALOA Youth Official Region (for Youth Officials Only): Please indicate your geographic region – the region that is applicable for where you live (i.e., Metro, East Side, South Sound, Dry Side – Eastern WA, etc.) This information is used to plan training sessions.

HS Grade: Provide your current year grade level.

After you register, we will be providing additional information regarding training opportunities and testing.

You also need to renew your membership at US Lacrosse – even if it is not set to expire yet. ALL OFFICIALS are required to renew their registrations prior to October 1.
