

# TOC PITCHING RULES - REGULAR SEASON RULES

## MAXIMUM LIMIT PER DAY -PAGE 44

13-16 95 PITCHES PER DAY

11-12 - 85 PITCHES PER DAY

9-10 - 75 PITCHES PER DAY

7-8 50 PITCHES PER DAY

**Exception: (page 44 & 134- 138) If a pitcher reaches a day(s) of rest threshold while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until any one of the following conditions occurs: 1. That batter reaches base; 2. That batter is retired; 3. The third out is made to complete the half-inning or the game. The pitcher will only be required to observe the calendar day(s) of rest for the threshold he/she reached during that at-bat, provided that pitcher is removed, or the game is completed before delivering a pitch to another batter.**

## MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING REST REQUIREMENTS

### 14 AND UNDER

66 PITCHES OR MORE - 4 DAYS REST

51-65 PITCHES - 3 DAYS REST

36-50 PITCHES - 2 DAYS REST

21-35 PITCHES - 1 DAYS REST

1-20 PITCHES - 0 DAYS REST

### 15 - 16

76 OR MORE PITCHES - 4 DAYS REST

61-75 PITCHES - 3 DAYS REST

46-60 PITCHES - 2 DAYS REST

31-45 PITCHES - 1 DAYS REST

1-30 PITCHES - 0 DAYS REST

FAILURE TO REMOVE A PITCHER WHO HAS REACHED HIS/HER MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PITCHES REQUIRED BY LEAGUE AGE OR USE OF AN INELIGIBLE PITCHER IS BASIS FOR PROTEST. DURING GAME JEANETTE FREDERICK IS TO BE CALLED. AFTER GAME AND PRIOR TO THE NEXT SCHEDULED GAME FOR EITHER TEAM, JEANETTE FREDERICK IS TO BE CALLED WITH ALL PARTICULARS. HER DECISION IS FINAL.

NOTE: Under no circumstances shall a player pitch in three (3) consecutive days.

**A PITCHER WHO DELIVERS FORTY-ONE (41) OR MORE PITCHES IN A GAME CANNOT PLAY THE POSITION OF CATCHER FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT DAY. ANY PLAYER, WHO HAS PLAYED THE POSITION OF CATCHER IN 4 OR MORE INNINGS IN A GAME, IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO PITCH ON THAT CALENDAR DAY.**

JR. /SR.: A PITCHER REMAINING IN THE GAME, BUT MOVING TO A DIFFERENT POSITION, CAN RETURN AS A PITCHER ANYTIME IN THE REMAINDER OF THE GAME, BUT ONLY ONCE.

# ALL STAR PITCHING RULES

## MAXIMUM LIMIT PER DAY – 135 - 138

13- 16 (Senior) – 95 PITCHES PER DAY

13-14 - 95 PITCHES PER DAY

11-12 - 85 PITCHES PER DAY

9-10 - 75 PITCHES PER DAY

8 – 50 PITCHES PER DAY

**Exception: (page 43 & 134 - 138) If a pitcher reaches a day(s) of rest threshold while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until any one of the following conditions occurs: 1. That batter reaches base; 2. That batter is retired; 3. The third out is made to complete the half-inning or the game. The pitcher will only be required to observe the calendar day(s) of rest for the threshold he/she reached during that at-bat, provided that pitcher is removed, or the game is completed before delivering a pitch to another batter.**

## **MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING REST REQUIREMENTS NOTE THIS ON THE AFFIDAVIT PITCHING RECORD**

### 14 AND UNDER

66 PITCHES OR MORE - 4 DAYS REST

51-65 PITCHES - 3 DAYS REST

36-50 PITCHES - 2 DAYS REST

21-35 PITCHES - 1 DAYS REST

1-20 PITCHES - 0 DAYS REST

### 13 – 16 SENIORS

76 OR MORE PITCHES - 4 DAYS REST

61-75 PITCHES - 3 DAYS REST

46-60 PITCHES - 2 DAYS REST

31-45 PITCHES - 1 DAYS REST

1-30 PITCHES - 0 DAYS REST

FAILURE TO REMOVE A PITCHER WHO HAS REACHED HIS/HER MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PITCHES REQUIRED BY LEAGUE AGE OR USE OF AN INELIGIBLE PITCHER IS BASIS FOR PROTEST. IF PROTESTED DURING THE GAME - SAN BERNARDINO IS TO BE CALLED. IF AFTER THE GAME AND PRIOR TO EITHER TEAM PLAYING THEIR NEXT GAME - JEANETTE FREDERICK IS TO BE CALLED WITH ALL PARTICULARS. SHE WILL CALL SAN BERNARDINO.

NOTE: Under no circumstances shall a player pitch in three (3) consecutive days.

**A PITCHER WHO DELIVERS FORTY-ONE (41) OR MORE PITCHES IN A GAME CANNOT PLAY THE POSITION OF CATCHER FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT DAY. ANY PLAYER, WHO HAS PLAYED THE POSITION OF CATCHER IN 4 OR MORE INNINGS IN A GAME, IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO PITCH ON THAT CALENDAR DAY.**

**JR. /SR.:** A PITCHER REMAINING IN THE GAME, BUT MOVING TO A DIFFERENT POSITION, CAN RETURN AS A PITCHER ANYTIME IN THE REMAINDER OF THE GAME, BUT ONLY ONCE.
