

CCLC December Update

Registration is well underway if you have not registered, please do so. Winter training announcements will come out soon and only those registered will be able to participate. As always, the club will use these announcements and postings to the DOCUMENTS section on the website to share important news. If it is not announced or shared, chances are high that final decisions have not been made yet.

Some important information to share regarding our lacrosse season:

Coaching Assignments: projected coaching assignments have been made and are as follows:

- A1: Kent Zambelli (Head Coach) and Jeff Senior
- A2/3: Dave Ellis (Head Coach) and an assistant to be named later
- B1: Mike Rama (Head Coach), Kevin Callahan and Dave Sowers
- B2/3: To be named later pending team assignments
- C1: Dave Gibbs (Head Coach) and Dan Connaughton
- It is highly possible that each of the teams has other assistant coaching support

Some key dates to make you aware of:

- **Winter training will begin in mid to end of January and February.** Look out for notes and on the website regarding exact times as they are announced. All training will be on Sunday mornings at the Maple Glen Elementary School. We realize this is not a convenient time for many. However, this is the only time we have available from the township. We have found that despite the poor timing, this is well attended. There will be sessions for 3rd/4th, 5th/6th and 7/8th. Details to follow as we approach.
- **Practice for grades 1-4** will start the **first week of April** when the fields open and are available for play.
- **Practice for grades 5-8** will start the **end of February** OUTSIDE at Sparks. Practice and tryouts will occur during this time period and continue into March as needed.
- **A1 & B1 tryouts:** rough A1 and B1 teams will be formed in advance of the Battle of Fort Washington but official teams not announced until AFTER the Battle and in advance of the regular season
- **Battle of Fort of Washington** (our local managed tournament) – will be played the **weekend of March 7th & 8th**. This tournament will include gameplay at the 5th/6th (B1 & B2/3) and the 7th/8th (A1 & A2/3) level. Details will be forthcoming from the Battle of Fort Washington committee.
- **Regular game season starts after April 1st** – typically this is when townships allow teams on their grass fields
- **Moorestown, NJ Lacrosse Festival – Saturday, May 16th** – Tournament gameplay against teams from all over the northeast. Currently, both “A” teams, both “B” teams and the 3rd/4th grade “C1” team will be scheduled to play at this tournament.
