

**NORTH SUNRISE LITTLE LEAGUE
BY-LAWS
2015**

ARTICLE 1

Section 1. Principle Office: The principle office for the transaction of business of NORTH SUNRISE LITTLE LEAGUE of Orange, California, is hereby fixed and located at 2143 Oakmont in the City of Orange, County of Orange, State of California.

The Board of Directors is hereby granted full power and authority to change said principle office from one location to another in said county.

ARTICLE 2

Membership

Section 1. Eligibility: Any person sincerely interested in active participation to effect the objectives of NORTH SUNRISE LITTLE LEAGUE may apply and become a Regular member.

Section 2. Classes: There shall be three classes of members: Board Members, Regular and Player.

Section 3. Board Members are elected annually. Candidates for the Board volunteer or are nominated. Secretary compiles candidate names on a ballot. Regular members are given one ballot per family at end of regular spring season. Votes are tallied by President and Secretary. (Amended 2015)

ARTICLE 3

Dues

Section 1. Dues for Board members are fixed as such amounts as the Board of Directors shall determine prior to the beginning of any membership period. Effective May 15, 2014, Board Members dues shall be fixed at \$0.00 minimum per the annual elected term as defined in Article 4, Section 1.

ARTICLE 4

Section 1. Board and Number: The management of the affairs of the league shall be vested in the Board of Directors. The number of directors shall not be more than twenty (20). The Directors shall upon elections immediately enter into the performance of their duties and shall continue in office until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified.

Section 2. Required Board Members: The Board shall consist of the Officers, Player Agent, at least one Manager and one volunteer Umpire. (Only volunteer umpires may be elected to the Board.) The number of managers including minor system representation elected to the Board shall not exceed a minority of the total Board members.

Section 3. The board shall have the power by a two-thirds vote of those present at any regular or special meeting to discipline, suspend, or remove any director, officer, or committee member of the league, subject to provisions of the constitution. (Refer to operating manual pg. 35 League Officers-Board of Directors.)

Section 4. Changes to Local Rules, League Constitution, League Charter are subject to approval by a two-thirds vote of those present at any regular meeting.

ARTICLE 5

Managers, Coaches and Umpires (Assistant Safety Officers)

Section 1. Team managers and coaches shall be appointed annually by the President, with the approval of the Board of Directors, and shall be responsible for the selection of their teams and for their actions on the field.

Section 2. Umpires officiating games in the AAA and Major Divisions shall be appointed annually by the Chief Umpire, with the approval of the Board of Directors. The UIC shall be responsible for their assignments.

Section 3. Team managers and coaches shall also serve as assistant safety officers, and shall assist Chief Safety Officer in the following manner:

- A. Check the playing field for unsafe conditions.
- B. Stop all unsafe acts and horseplay by team members.
- C. Submit parent medical release and/or doctor's releases to the Chief Safety Officer and snack stand for easy access during season.
- D. Instruct players on safety rules and programs throughout the season.
- E. Complete accident investigations forms within 48 hours of the accident.

ARTICLE 6

Field Duty Officer/Board Member on Duty

Section 1. All Board Members will, by assignment schedule, act as Field Duty Officer/Board Member on Duty on a regular basis.

Section 2. Field Duty Officer/Board Member on Duty will work with the Safety Officer in correcting unsafe conditions.

Section 3. Field Duty Officer/Board Member on Duty will keep spectators and children away from fences, dugouts, playing fields before, during and after games.

Section 4. Assist Snack Stand personnel in closing up operations and escort them to their vehicles.

Section 5. Check equipment storage area and playing areas for loose equipment, fences, bases, umpire gear, etc.

ARTICLE 7

Documents, Records and Reports

Section 1. Execution of Documents: The Board of Directors may authorize any Officer and Director to enter into any contract or execute any instrument in the name of or on behalf of the league, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances; and unless so authorized by the Board, no Officer or Director shall have any power or authority to bind the league by any contract or engagement, or pledge its credit, or to render it liable for any purpose or for any amount.

Section 2. Inspection of Records: The league shall keep at its principle office, the original or copy of these By-Laws, as amended or otherwise altered to date, certified by the Secretary; Its Articles of Incorporation, as amended or otherwise altered to date, all of which shall be open to inspection by the members of the league at all reasonable times and in the manner provided by the Corporations Code of the State of California. The account books and records of the league shall be open to inspection by members of the league at all reasonable times in the manner provided by the Corporations Code of the State of California.

ARTICLE 8

Amendments

Section 1. Amendments: Subject to any provision of law applicable to the amendment of: Bylaws or non-profit organizations, these Bylaws may be amended, repealed or new Bylaws adopted by a majority of the members of the Board of Directors, at any Board Meeting, provided written notice of the proposed changes are provided to all Board Members not less than fourteen (14) days before the meeting at which time a vote on the changes may occur.

Section 2. Whenever an amendment or new Bylaw is adopted, it shall be placed with the original Bylaws in the Book of Bylaws. If these Bylaws are repealed, in whole or in part, the fact of

repeal, with the date of meeting at which the repeal was enacted, shall be stated in said Book of Bylaws.
