Attendance and Participation:

Concentrate on developing skills and teamwork.

No goofing off.

Accept the coaches' direction and decision regarding playing time, team and positioning.

Maintain academic eligibility.

Plan study time in a way that minimizes absences from practices and games.

Safety and Equipment:

Use the required lacrosse equipment at practices and games.
