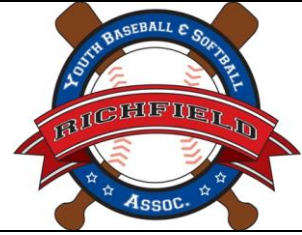


## 2013 Richfield Youth Baseball & Softball Association (RYBSA) Volunteer Policies and Instructions



### ***Why donate your time to volunteer for the RYBSA?***

- The RYBSA is an organization run entirely by volunteers and we need the help of our families to be successful
- If an adult member of your family volunteers two or more hours during the current baseball/softball season, you will receive a credit of \$50 (payable at the end of the season)

### ***How do I volunteer?***

1. View eligible volunteer opportunities on the "[Volunteering](#)" section of the RYBSA Web site.
2. When you find an opportunity that you are interested in, click the button "Sign Up". It's that simple - no emails or phone calls to make.

### ***Who is exempt from having to volunteer?***

- A team's head coach
- A team's official assistant coach (one per team)
- Any league board member or coordinator
- Any family that has children that are only in the T-ball league (T-ball-only families did not pay a \$50 deposit with their child's registration)

### ***What does NOT qualify for volunteer credit?***

- Helping your child's coach by keeping the scorebook
- Keeping score on the electronic scoreboards during the game
- Helping out at your child's practices
- Any activity not officially on the Volunteer Opportunities section of the RYBSA Web site

### ***Will there be any additional opportunities later in the year?***

If additional volunteer opportunities arise throughout the year, those will be added to the Volunteering section of the RYBSA Web site.
