Financial Report - Meagan Jarecki

- Meagan distributed budget for the season which starts each April; full report posted on website
- Please see Meagan if you are interested in using a reloadable King Soopers card where 5% of each dollar loaded on the card will be deposited into your players account
- Monies you earn from your King Soopers card can be used to offset other costs (e.g. end of season banquet, summer camps, Metro League, etc.)
- Parents have requested that instead of collecting monies throughout the season that a one-time player fee be determined and paid at the start of the season. The fee is currently calculated to be \$260 assumes 29 players and includes costs for the following:
 - Memory Book
 - November Team Building (this is an overnight for the girls and coaches at a local hotel after tryouts; date TBD)
 - Sweats (that the players get to keep)
 - Capital Fund to be used for future recurring expenses such as new uniforms
 - January Team Building (last year it was going to Boulder to watch a CU Women's game)
 - Concession start up (money used to purchase food and drinks to sell)
 - Technology Fund

Misc. Topics

- Mission Statement & Board Member Duties - Lori updated these documents and reviewed with other Board members; she will post them to the website.
- Concessions- Mike sent ideas for pricing (e.g. whole dollars) and food selections; will probably use sign up genius for parents to volunteer for the games they will be running the concession stand; more to come on this at the Tip Off Event
- Team Dinners - some discussion on how to manage the size of the groups as the girls prefer to all be together rather than separate by teams; again, more to come on this topic at the Tip Off Event
